NEW ORLEANS ZEPHYRS (8-9) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (9-7)

‘TOPES RIP ZEPHYRS 12-8: To the delight of 12,171 fans, the largest crowd of the season, the Albuquerque Isotopes erupted for 10 runs over the sixth and seventh innings to outpace the New Orleans Zephyrs 12-8 on a Friday fireworks night at Isotopes Park. Albuquerque jumped on top in the top of the first when the electric Dee Gordon led off the game with a single, stole second and scored all the way from second base on a wild pitch to give the Isotopes a 1-0 lead. The Z’s responded in the fourth thanks to a two-run homer by Mike Cervenak to give the visiting team a 2-1 edge, but the Isotopes knotted the game in the bottom of the fourth in a rally started by Jamie Hoffmann, who roped a one-out single, advanced to third on a single by Trayvon Robinson, and scored on an RBI groundout by J.D. Closser to tie the game a 2-2. Again, New Orleans seized the lead right back with a run in the fifth and another in the sixth to take a 4-2 advantage. The Isotopes emphatically stormed back in the bottom of the sixth, to take the game by the throat. With the bases loaded and nobody out, Robinson knocked a single up the middle, plating a pair to knot the game at 4-4. J.D. Closser than dumped a single to right that was overrun by Chris Aguila for a fielding error, allowing two more to score and give Albuquerque a 6-4 lead. After a sacrifice moved Closser to third, a pinch-hit sac-fly by Trent Oeltjen plated the runner, extending the lead to 7-4 ‘Topes. Albuquerque’s deluge continued in the seventh, when Russ Mitchell led off the frame with a solo homer. Following back-to-back-to-back singles to load the bases, Robinson unloaded them with a triple to the gap in right-center, blowing the game open at 11-4 Albuquerque. A sacrifice fly by Closser, his third RBI of the night, scored Robinson to increase the cushion to 12-4 Isotopes. New Orleans would mount one final comeback, scoring four times in the ninth, three on a blast by Ruben Gotay, but it was too little, too late, as the ‘Topes held on for a 12-8 series-opening victory.

FELIX ON THE SPOT: Right-hander Francisco Felix takes the mound on a spot start, his first of the season. Even though he’s coming out of the bullpen, Felix is no stranger to starting. Last year, after spending most of the season with Saltillo in the Mexican League, the right-hander was a late-season addition to the ‘Topes at the end of August and was inserted into the rotation immediately, making two starts (winning them both). Felix has been tremendous out of the ‘pen so far this season, posting a 1-0 record with a 1.80 ERA in three appearances. After joining the Isotopes on April 11 from Extended Spring, Felix got the win in his very first appearance for the ‘Topes this season, tossing 2.1 innings of relief in a 10-7 win over Iowa, allowing just one run (the only run he’s allowed this year) on two hits while walking one and striking out two.

SECOND TO NONE: Albuquerque has yet to lose the second game of a series this year. In four tries so far this season, the ‘Topes are a perfect 4-0 in the second game of a set.

A PERFECT 10: The longest hitting streak of the season by an Isotope now belongs to Trayvon Robinson, who has now hit in 10 straight games thanks to his 3-for-4 performance last night. Over the course of his streak, the outfielder has batted .471 (16x34) with 10 runs, a double, two triples, three homers, and an astounding 17 RBI. Since his streak began on April 12, Robinson and Reno’s David Winfree are tied for the most RBI in the PCL, helped in part to a career-high five RBI for the Isotopes outfielder in last night’s game.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Francisco Felix makes the spot start, his first of the season, after three excellent appearances out of the bullpen in which he's posted a 1-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (1 ER / 5.0 IP). Joined Albuquerque on April 11 from Extended Spring Training and earned a victory in his first appearance for the 'Topes in 2011, pitching 2.1 innings of relief on April 13 vs. Iowa, allowing a run on two hits while walking one and striking out two in a 10-7 Albuquerque win.

2010: Spent the majority of the season on loan to Saltillo of the Mexican League after making his first appearance at Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee... went 1-3 with a 6.28 ERA (43 ER / 61.2 IP) in 17 games (12 starts) for Saltillo... added to Albuquerque on August 28 and made two starts for the Isotopes, going 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP)... pitched through the sixth in both outings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2009 season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 4-2 with a 3.07 ERA (26 ER / 76.2 IP) in a total of 43 appearances... started the season at Chattanooga, going 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA and two saves in 29 games... was 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER / 18.2 IP) and a save in nine appearances in May... made a pair of starts for Lookouts, his first since 2007, and went 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (3 ER / 6.2 IP)... went 3-1 with two saves and a 2.77 ERA (15 ER / 48.2 IP) while holding opponents to a .222 batting average in 27 relief appearances... transferred to Albuquerque on July 25... went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (8 ER / 21.1 IP) in 14 appearances... earned his only win for the Isotopes in the second game of a doubleheader after pitching a perfect seventh in a 2-1 Albuquerque win... his only save was of the two-inning variety on August 8 vs. Portland... pitched a 0.1 inning of scoreless relief in Game 3 of the Isotopes' playoff series vs. Memphis... pitched for Culiacan of the Mexican Winter League for the fourth straight season, going 2-1 with a 2.43 ERA (11 ER / 40.2 IP) in 32 appearances (one start).

Split 2008 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Triple-A Las Vegas, going a combined 5-4 with a 4.27 ERA and three saves in 40 total games... began season at Inland Empire, posting a 5-3 record with a 3.31 ERA and two saves... was 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA and two saves in 12 games at home, 1-2 with a 4.13 in 13 games on the road... ranked fifth among all California League relievers by holding batters to a .198 average... was 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA in seven games in June... yielded just two hits over 11 straight scoreless innings from June 6 to June 18... held left-handed hitters to a .145 average, while righties batted .238... transferred to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 8 and finished the season going 0-1 with a 5.81 ERA and a save in 15 appearances.

Played at two Single-A levels, Great Lakes and Inland Empire IN 2007, going 3-4 with a 3.87 ERA and three saves in 39 total games between both stops... began season at Great Lakes and allowed just three earned runs in 35.1 innings-pitched over 10 games (three starts) for a 0.76 ERA... fanned 35 batters while walking just nine and did not allow a home run over that span... named Dodgers' Co-Pitcher of the Month for April after posting a 0.48 ERA and holding opposing hitters to a .145 average... promoted to Inland Empire on May 18 and went 2-3 with a 5.51 ERA in 29 games (four starts).
