ZEPHYRS OUTLAST ISOTOPES 10-9: The Albuquerque Isotopes put the tying run in scoring position with two out in the ninth but couldn't push him home, falling to the New Orleans Zephyrs 10-9 on a beautiful Easter Sunday at Isotopes Park. Both teams started scoring early and often, as the Isotopes plated a run in the first only to have New Orleans answer with a run in the second before the Z's grabbed the lead with three in the third that made the score 3-1 Zephyrs. Albuquerque showed it could deliver the long ball in the fourth when Trayvon Robinson smashed a solo homer to left, bringing the Isotopes to within 3-2. Dee Gordon added an RBI single, scoring Justin Sellers to tie the contest at 3-3. New Orleans surged ahead with three runs in the fifth on solo homers by Vinny Rottino and Joe Thurston before Chris Aguila knocked a triple and immediately scored on a single by Josh Kroeger to give the visitors a 6-3 lead. Albuquerque bounced back with two runs in the bottom of the frame, but again, the Zephyrs tacked on two more in the top of the sixth, making the score 8-5. Corey Smith hammered a two-run blast in the sixth, his first homer as an Isotope, to bring the home team to within 8-6 until the eventual clinching knock came in the top of the seventh, when Clint Sammons delivered a two-run homer to left, giving New Orleans a four-run cushion at 10-6. The Z's would end up needing every inch of that cushion as Sellers blasted a solo homer in the seventh to bring the 'Topes to within 10-7 before Albuquerque added one more tally in the eighth on a run-scoring double-play to make it 10-9 Z's. Robinson gave the Isotopes life in the ninth with a lead-off single and was pushed to second on a walk to Wilberto Ortiz, but that's where the drive would end as Zephyrs closer Jose Ceda retired Gordon to end the game and preserve the wild 10-9 New Orleans victory.

MR. NEAR NO-NO: Although he started the season with the Isotopes, tonight will be the first start at Isotopes Park for right-hander John Ely, who was called up to the Dodgers during the 'Topes' first homestand and made two previous starts on Albuquerque's last road trip. It's safe to say Ely arrives at his first start in Albuquerque with some momentum, coming off a near no-hitter in his last start. In the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Ely entered the seventh and final inning having not surrendered a hit and promptly struck out the first two batters he faced. With the right-hander just one out away from becoming the first Isotope in team history to throw a no-hitter, Marquez Smith roped a double down the third base line, breaking up the no-no. Unfazed, Ely then retired the last batter to finish off what was a one-hit, complete-game shutout, the first of his career.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK! By virtue of his one-hit shutout, John Ely has been named Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week for games beginning on April 18 and continuing through April 24th. Ely becomes the first Isotope to grab a PCL Player of the Week accolade this season and the first 'Topes pitcher to win the award since Seth Etherton took league Pitcher of the Week honors for May 24 to June 1 last year.

THIS ONE GOES TO 11: With his solo home run yesterday, Trayvon Robinson emphatically extended his team-leading hitting streak to 11 straight games. Over the course of his streak, the outfielder has batted .471 (18x39) with 11 runs, a double, two triples, four homers, and an astounding 18 RBI. Robinson's is now tied for the third longest streak in the PCL this season behind former Isotope Tony Abreu and Salt Lake's Alexi Amarista, who have each hit in 14 straight games.

SMITH STILL SMOKING: Corey Smith continues to swing a hot bat, collecting three hits yesterday, including his first home run as an Isotope. In six games, Smith has racked up 10 hits in 26 at-bats (.385) with two doubles, a homer, and seven RBI.

TODAY'S START: John Ely makes his first start at Isotopes Park this season coming off an outing in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20 in which he nearly threw a no-hitter. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Enjoyed a breakout 2009 season in his first year at Double-A with Birmingham in the Chicago White Sox organization, going 14-2 with a 2.82 ERA (49 ER / 156.1 IP) in 27 starts... tied for first in the Southern League with 14 wins and was first in strikeouts with 125... ranked third in the SL in ERA and second in innings-pitched (156.1)... was also third in the league in WHIP (1.22) and fifth in average against (.241)... averaged 7.20 strikeouts / nine-innings, third most in the SL while allowing 11 base-runners / nine-innings, third fewest in the circuit... overall, limited right-handed hitters to a .217 average (70x322)... named Southern League Mid-Season All-Star on July 13... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on July 20... named to the Southern League Post-Season All-Star team on August 31... traded from the White Sox with right-hander Jon Link for outfielder Juan Pierre on December 18.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/ Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game... selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
