'TOPES FEND OFF ZEPHYRS IN 13-8 WIN: Catcher Damaso Espino banged out four hits and drove in five runs to pace the Albuquerque Isotopes offense to a 13-8 win over the New Orleans Zephyrs on a blustery Tuesday afternoon at Isotopes Park. Early on it was evident the contest was going to be a shootout, as New Orleans scored two times in the top of the first, only to watch Albuquerque roar back with three in the bottom of the frame. The Isotopes bolstered the advantage in the third when Jamie Hoffmann roped a double and scored on a two-out knock by Espino to help the home team open up a 4-2 advantage. Wilberto Ortiz then followed with a double that plated Espino before starting pitcher Dana Eveland capped the inning's scoring with a base hit, plating Ortiz and making the score 6-2 'Topes. Albuquerque erupted for four more tallies in the fourth when Trayvon Robinson and Trent Oeltjen led off the frame with back-to-back singles before Corey Smith hammered a double, plating Robinson and increasing the lead to 7-2 Isotopes. After a walk to Hoffmann loaded the bases with nobody out, Russ Mitchell drove home Oeltjen with an RBI groundout, setting up the red-hot Espino, who hit yet another two-run single, giving the home team a 10-2 cushion. As history has shown, no lead at Isotopes Park is entirely safe and New Orleans set about immediately proving the point, scoring twice in the fifth and once in the sixth to cut the lead to 10-5. Then, with two on and two out in the eighth, Bryan Petersen delivered a three-run homer, bringing the Zephyrs all the way back to within 10-8. The 'Topes would make sure that's as close as the surging Zephyrs would get, however, plating three valuable insurance runs in the bottom of the eighth to essentially put the game on ice. After Hoffmann roped his second double of the game, Espino hit a sharp grounder to second, where Juan Marchan fielded the ball on his knees but threw wildly to first, allowing Hoffmann to score. Pinch-hitter J.D. Closser then administered the final nail in the coffin for the Isotopes, lining a two-run single to center that sent Albuquerque coasting to a 13-8 win.

REDDING READY FOR A WIN: Right-hander Tim Redding makes his fourth start of the season still looking for his first victory after suffering the defeat in his last outing on April 22 in a bizarre, fog-shortened game at Iowa. With the 'Topes trailing 7-2 in the bottom of the sixth, a heavy fog enveloped Principal Park in Des Moines, causing the game to be called complete at that point with Albuquerque, and Redding, taking the defeat. In three previous starts, the right-hander has gone 0-2 with a 13.14 ERA (18 ER / 12.1 IP) and has yet to make it through the fifth inning in any of his outings.

BAKER'S DOZEN ON A TRAY: With a pair of knocks in his last game, Trayvon Robinson has now hit safely in 13 straight games, batting a scorching .412 (21x51) with 13 runs, a double, two triples, four homers, and 18 RBI since the streak began on April 12. The streak is now the third longest in the PCL this season behind Reno's Wily Mo Pena, who had his 15-game hitting streak come to an end on Tuesday. Even more impressive, however, is that Robinson has reached base in every game he's played at the Triple-A level, a stretch of 17 straight games that began with a base knock on Opening Day.

HAPPENIN' AT THE HERSCH: Albuquerque makes its first visit to Herschel Greer Stadium in Nashville, a place that's been historically tough on the 'Topes. All-time, the Isotopes are 29-34 in Nashville, and have posted a winning record in a season series at Nashville just twice in team history (2010 and 2005, when the 'Topes went 5-3 at Greer). Overall, the Isotopes are 59-67 all-time against the Sounds.

WORTH THE WAIT: After starting out his Triple-A career 0-for-13 over seven games, Wilberto Ortiz broke out with two hits, including a double, two runs, and an RBI on Tuesday. In the bottom of the third inning in Albuquerque's 13-8 win over New Orleans, Ortiz roped an RBI double for his first Triple-A hit.

A.J.'S BACK: Catcher A.J. Ellis returns to Albuquerque after being optioned by the Dodgers on April 25 to make room for catcher Dioner Navarro. Ellis comes to the Isotopes having been hot in the big leagues. In six games with L.A. this season Ellis, batted .267 (4x15) with a run and two RBI, but dating back to last September, Ellis is batting .373 (19x51) in his last 22 games played in the Major Leagues.

BARK IN THE PARK: The Isotopes are teaming up with Animal Humane of New Mexico to bring "Bark In The Park" to The Lab on a busy Mother's Day on Sunday, May 8. Fans can bring their four-legged pals to enjoy a 'Topes game from the Creamland Berm, where Animal Humane will set up water stations and waste receptacles. Dogs must arrive with proof of rabies vaccination, identification, valid license and must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older.

TODAY'S START: Tim Redding looks for his first win of the season after suffering the loss on April 22 at Iowa when he allowed six runs, five earned, on a season-high 10 hits in four innings of a 7-2 fog-shortened, six-inning loss to the Cubs. Took the loss in his first outing on April 10 vs. Omaha when he yielded nine runs on eight hits in four innings while walking three and striking out five in a 9-6 'Topes loss.

Made an appearance in right field on April 13 vs. Iowa when the Isotopes ran out of position players due to injuries. Played three innings at the position but did not face any chances. Also made one appearance as a pinch-hitter on April 14 vs. Iowa (grounded out to third).

2010: Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Rockies organization and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the New York (AL) organization... allowed just four home runs in 109.0 combined innings... opened the season with Colorado Springs, making five starts before his release on May 6... signed by the Yankees on May 13 and assigned to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre... in 13 games (12 starts) with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, limited opposing hitters to a .221 average (68x307), including a .189 mark against right-handers (30x159)... finished the season on a five-game winning streak, going 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA (4 ER / 43.1 IP) over six games (five starts) from July 4 to July 31... released by the Yankees on August 5 and finished the season with the Samsung Lions in the Korea Baseball Organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the 2009 season in New York (NL) organization, making 30 appearances (17 starts) for the Mets... made two starts in Spring Training on March 8 and March 12 before landing on the 15-Day Disabled List April 5th (retroactive to March 27th) with a strained right rotator cuff... had two rehabilitation starts (no decisions) with Triple-A Buffalo... made his Mets debut on May 18 at Los Angeles (NL) after being activated from the 15-Day DL earlier in the day... picked up his first hit in a Mets uniform, a single to right field in the fifth inning... picked up his first win as a member of the Mets on June 22 at home vs. St. Louis... tied his season-high with 7.0 innings and allowed 4 runs and 5 hits (the last Mets pitcher to go winless in his first six starts was Hideo Nomo in 1998)... moved to the bullpen after his start on July 2 in Pittsburgh... as a reliever, compiled a 5.63 ERA (15 ER / 24.0 IP) in 13 games and lost his only decision... moved back to the rotation for a start on August 22 vs. Philadelphia... in his first two starts after moving back into the rotation, he was 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA (3 ER / 11.2 IP).

Established career highs in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts with the Washington Nationals in 2008... following the season, had calcium deposit removed from the joint of his second toe on his left foot... finished tied for ninth in the NL with 33 starts... did not miss his turn in the rotation the entire season... matched his career-high in wins with 10 (also won 10 games for Houston in 2003)... became first Nats pitcher to record double figures in victories since the 2006 season... Washington went 20-13 in his starts... in his first start of the year, went 7.0 innings to beat the Phillies, 1-0, at Citizens Bank Park on April 2... established career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a 6-4 victory at Florida on April 18... threw career-best 8.0 innings, his first Major League complete game, in a 1-0 loss on July 24 at San Francisco.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Timothy James Redding... is married to Jaime with a daughter, Shea (11/13/01), and son, Brennan (9/15/03)... graduated from Monroe Community College in Rochester, NY, where his No. 17 jersey became the first in school history to be retired on Feb. 1, 2008... his great aunt, Joyce Randolph, played Trixie Norton on the Honeymooners.
