### ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (13-8) AT NASHVILLE SOUNDS (8-13)

**BASTARDO BRILLIANT IN 4-1 'TOPES WIN:** Left-hander Alberto Bastardo out-dued former Cy Young Award winner Zack Greinke to lead the Albuquerque Isotopes to a 4-1 triumph over the Nashville Sounds Friday night at Greer Stadium. Bastardo (2-0) allowed the Sounds just one run on a mere five hits in 7.1 innings, the longest outing logged by a 'Topes starter this season. The left-hander walked two, struck out five, and at one point from the fourth to the eighth, retired 11 Nashville batters in a row. Greinke (0-1) was excellent as well, allowing two runs on seven hits in five innings while walking one and striking out seven. The 2009 Cy Young Award winner's only mistake came in the fourth, when Corey Smith singled and was followed immediately by a monstrous two-run homer by Jamie Hoffmann that broke a scoreless tie and gave Albuquerque a 2-0 lead. The Sounds tallied their only run of the game immediately in the bottom of the fourth, when Brendan Katin led off the inning with a double and was promptly cashed in on a base hit by former Isotope Brett Carroll that trimmed the lead to 2-1. That's exactly where the score would stay until the ninth, when for the second straight game, the 'Topes added some valuable insurance runs. Hoffmann again was right in the middle of the rally, starting the inning by beating out grounder to the hole in second for an infield hit. After a line-out and a fly-out, Wilberto Ortiz drew a walk in an epic nine-pitch at-bat to move Hoffmann into scoring position. Hard throwing Sounds reliever Justin James then threw not one, but two balls into the dirt for wild pitches, allowing Hoffmann to move to third and, ultimately, home to extend the Albuquerque advantage to 3-1. Pinch-hitter Trent Oeltjen added an emphatic cap to the scoring, blasting a triple to center that easily plated Ortiz while making the score 4-1 Isotopes.

**FROM SPOT STARTER TO SPOT IN THE ROTATION:** Due to a groin / hamstring injury to Randy Keisler, Francisco Felix has gone from spot starter to a member of the rotation. The right-hander made his first start of the season on April 24 and acquitted himself pretty well, allowing three runs on five hits in four innings while walking three and striking out three in a 10-9 loss to the New Orleans Zephyrs at Isotopes Park. Thanks to Felix's previous role as a middle reliever, the start in his last outing sufficiently stretched him out. The right-handed tossed 62 pitches in his start against New Orleans and will now see his work load reflect that of a starter's.

**THE STREAK CONTINUES:** With a base hit against Major League rehabbing righty Zack Greinke, Trayvon Robinson has increased his amazing hitting streak to 15 games, second longest in the Pacific Coast League so far this season to Reno's Wily Mo Pena's 16-game streak. Through his current tear, which is also a career-long for the outfielder, Robinson has batted .400 (24x60) with 13 runs, a double, two triples, four homers, and 19 RBI. Not only does his hitting streak roll on, but Robinson's consecutive on-base streak of 19 games also continues and is also second longest in the PCL behind Las Vegas' David Cooper's streak of 20 games. The outfielder has reached base in every game he's played for the Isotopes this year.

**HIGH WATER:** The Isotopes are currently enjoying their longest winning streak of the season at four games and with a record of 13-8, are the most games clear of .500, five, than they've been all year. The streak includes a pair of wins at Greer Stadium, where the 'Topes have a similar hot stretch going. Albuquerque has won seven of its last eight games played in the Music City dating back to June 3 of last year.

**'MAZING MERKIN:** Reliever Merkin Valdez has been lights out of late out of the Isotopes bullpen. The big right-hander hasn't allowed a run in each of his last five appearances stretching over 7.1 innings. In fact, aside from one outing against Iowa at Isotopes Park on April 13 when he gave up three runs, Valdez hasn't given up any runs at all over his seven other appearances. Over the course of his current scoreless streak, Valdez has held the opposition to a .167 batting average (4x24).

**BARK IN THE PARK:** The Isotopes are teaming up with Animal Humane of New Mexico to bring "Bark In The Park" to The Lab on a busy Mother's Day on Sunday, May 8. Fans can bring their four-legged pals to enjoy a 'Topes game from the Creamland Berm, where Animal Humane will set up water stations and waste receptacles. Dogs must arrive with proof of rabies vaccination, identification, valid license and must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older.

**TODAY'S START:** Francisco Felix makes his second start of the season after pitching 4.0 innings in his first start of the year on April 24 vs. New Orleans when he yielded three runs on five hits while walking three and striking out three in a 10-9 'Topes loss. Prior to moving to the rotation, he made three excellent appearances out of the bullpen in which he posted a 1-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (1 ER / 5.0 IP). Joined Albuquerque on April 11 from Extended Spring Training and earned a victory in his first appearance for the 'Topes in 2011, pitching 2.1 innings of relief on April 13 vs. Iowa, allowing a run on two hits while walking one and striking out two in a 10-7 Albuquerque win.

**2010:** Spent the majority of the season on loan to Saltillo of the Mexican League after making his first appearance at Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee... went 1-3 with a 6.28 ERA (43 ER / 61.2 IP) in 17 games (12 starts) for Saltillo... added to Albuquerque on August 28 and made two starts for the Isotopes, going 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP)... pitched through the sixth in both outings.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Split the 2009 season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 4-2 with a 3.07 ERA (26 ER / 76.2 IP) in a total of 43 appearances... started the season at Chattanooga, going 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA and two saves in 29 games... was 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER / 18.2 IP) and a save in nine appearances in May... made a pair of starts for Lookouts, his first since 2007, and went 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (3 ER / 6.2 IP)... went 3-1 with two saves and a 2.77 ERA (15 ER / 48.2 IP) while holding opponents to a .222 batting average in 27 relief appearances... transferred to Albuquerque on July 25... went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (8 ER / 21.1 IP) in 14 appearances... earned his only win for the Isotopes in the second game of a doubleheader after pitching a perfect seventh in a 2-1 Albuquerque win... his only save was of the two-inning variety on August 8 vs. Portland... pitched a 0.1 inning of scoreless relief in Game 3 of the Isotopes' playoff series vs. Memphis... pitched for Culiacan of the Mexican Winter League for the fourth straight season, going 2-1 with a 2.43 ERA (11 ER / 40.2 IP) in 32 appearances (one start).

Split 2008 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Triple-A Las Vegas, going a combined 5-4 with a 4.27 ERA and three saves in 40 total games... began season at Inland Empire, posting a 5-3 record with a 3.31 ERA and two saves... was 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA and two saves in 12 games at home, 1-2 with a 4.13 in 13 games on the road... ranked fifth among all California League relievers by holding batters to a .198 average... was 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA in seven games in June... yielded just two hits over 11 straight scoreless innings from June 6 to June 18... held left-handed hitters to a .145 average, while righties batted .238... transferred to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 8 and finished the season going 0-1 with a 5.81 ERA and a save in 15 appearances.

Played at two Single-A levels, Great Lakes and Inland Empire IN 2007, going 3-4 with a 3.87 ERA and three saves in 39 total games between both stops... began season at Great Lakes and allowed just three earned runs in 35.1 innings-pitched over 10 games (three starts) for a 0.76 ERA... named Dodgers' Co-Pitcher of the Month for April after posting a 0.48 ERA and holding opposing hitters to a .145 average.
