# COLORADO SPRINGS SKY SOX (18-27) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (25-18) RHP Claudio Vargas (0-2, 10.80 ERA) vs. LHP Dana Eveland (4-3, 3.94 ERA) Isotopes Park • Tuesday, May 24 • 6:35 P.M. MT

**ISOTOPES HOLD OFF SKY SOX, 5-4:** The Albuquerque Isotopes fended off a late rally by the Colorado Springs Sky Sox and held on to an exciting 5-4 win Monday night at Isotopes Park. The Sky Sox grabbed an early lead when Ian Stewart launched a solo homer in the top of the second to take a 1-0 lead, but the Isotopes answered in the bottom of the frame on a sacrifice fly by Damaso Espino that plated Jamie Hoffmann to knot the contest at 1-1. Albuquerque snapped the stalemate in the sixth, when John Lindsey crushed a monstrous solo homer to left center, putting the home team ahead 2-1. Hoffmann then added his third hit of the night to keep the rally going and moved into scoring position on an Ivan De Jesus Jr. single for Espino, who cashed in Hoffmann with a single to left-center to give the Isotopes a 3-1 edge. Lindsey would help the 'Topes bolster the advantage one inning later. Dee Gordon slapped a single to center, stole second, and scored with ease when Lindsey hammered a two-out double to left, giving Albuquerque a 4-1 advantage. Colorado Springs would tie the game with three in the eighth, but Albuquerque, and Espino had the last laugh, as the catcher knocked in Trayvon Robinson in the bottom of the inning to give the 'Topes a 5-4 lead. Merkin Valdez made the lead stick with a perfect ninth to seal the Albuquerque victory and earn his third save of the season.

**DEALIN' DANA:** Left-hander Dana Eveland takes the mound coming off a pair of superb outings. Starting with his appearance on May 13 in Las Vegas, Eveland has allowed just two runs in his last 14 innings of work (1.28 ERA). The only thing that kept him from getting a pair of wins in that span is a no-decision on May 19 vs. Reno that may have been his best performance of the season. In that appearance, Eveland worked a season-high eight innings, allowing two runs on eight hits while walking three and striking out four. The left-hander departed when the game was tied 2-2, but the 'Topes plated a run in the bottom of the ninth on a walk-off homer by Jamie Hoffmann to give Albuquerque a 3-2 win. Eveland's eight innings in that contest was the longest by an Isotopes starter until John Ely's nine-inning complete game three days later.

A PITCHER'S WORTH 1,000 WORDS: Coming into the current homestand, Isotopes pitchers had posted an ERA of 5.74 at Isotopes Park, but in the five games since, 'Topes hurlers have an ERA of 3.40 (17 ER / 45.0 IP) at the hitter-friendly Lab. Of course, it begins with the starters, who have been excellent. In the last five games, Albuquerque starting pitchers have racked up a 3.40 ERA (13 ER / 34.1 IP), accumulating three quality starts over that span.

**ISOTOPES BELONG IN THE LAB:** The Isotopes continue to be the toughest team to beat at home in the Pacific Coast League. The 'Topes have won eight of their last 10 games played at Isotopes Park, running their record at home to 17-8, by far the best home mark in the PCL. By taking four of their last five on the current homestand, the Isotopes have advanced their record on the season to 25-18, a season-high seven games above .500. Most important, Albuquerque is now just a half game behind Round Rock in the PCL's American Southern Division, the closest the 'Topes have been to the top spot in the division since they were a half game back on May 2.

**HOFFY HEATIN' UP:** Jamie Hoffmann has gotten a hit in five of his last six games, racking up nine knocks in 22 at-bats over that span (.409 average). Three of the games in which Hoffmann has gotten a hit have been multi-hit performances, raising his total of multi-hit games this year to 11.

BIG HOMESTAND ROLLS ON!!: The 'Topes continue their eightgame homestand today with an Adult Fun Run, where everyone, kids (and kids at heart), is invited to run the bases on the field at Isotopes Park. Tomorrow, the Isotopes will roll out their annual baseball card set, perfect for collectors!

Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting
traded to Pittsburgh on June 1 in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER /
20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67) allowed just two earned
runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned
wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago
(AL)) threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while
striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6 went 0-1

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation...compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
