COLORADO SPRINGS SKY SOX (19-28) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (26-19)

‘TOPES SCORE 7-6 WALK-OFF WIN IN TEN: Eugenio Velez’s two-out RBI single to center in the bottom of the 10th-inning gave the Albuquerque Isotopes an exciting 7-6 victory over the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on Wednesday night at Isotopes Park. With the contest knotted at 6-6 in the bottom of the tenth, Dee Gordon got things going with a two-out bunt single towards third base. That brought in the rehabbing Casey Blake, who knocked a single to right field, which moved Gordon to third. With runners at the corners, Velez then took the first pitch from Colorado Springs reliever Rex Brothers and plunked it to shallow right-center field, bringing home Gordon and giving Albuquerque the win. The Sky Sox shot to a 2-0 lead in the top of the first before tacking on another run in the second giving the visitors a 3-0 lead. The ‘Topes got on the board in the bottom of the fourth inning, which started with a triple to center from Velez. Trent Oeltjen then stepped up and doubled to left-center, scoring the runner easily and bringing Albuquerque to within 3-1. Both sides traded a single run apiece in the fourth inning, making the score 4-2 in favor of the Sky Sox, but in the bottom of the sixth, the Isotopes surged for four runs to take the lead. Velez continued his solid night with a lead-off single, then stole second and moved to third on a groundout by Oeltjen. He then came home while John Lindsey was able to reach first on a Colorado Springs throwing error. With the deficit down to 4-3, Jamie Hoffmann singled and Trayvon Robinson reached on yet another error by the Sox to load the bases. A.J. Ellis then drew a walk to bring home Lindsey and tie the game at 4-4. After that, J.D. Closser came in to pinch-hit and socked a single up the middle to plate both Hoffmann and Robinson. The home team’s 6-4 edge lasted until the eighth inning, when the Sky Sox’ plated a run before tying the contest on a Jeff Salazar homer in the top of the ninth.

BASTARDO, AND HIS BACK, ARE BACK: Lefty Alberto Bastardo returns to the mound after skipping his last start due to stiffness in his back that threatened to spoil what had been a terrific season. After a superb outing on May 15 at Tucson in which he allowed the T-Pads three runs on seven hits over seven innings of a 10-5 ‘Topes win, the lefty experienced some slight soreness in his lower back, which caused him to miss his next scheduled start on May 21. After getting treatment, Bastardo avoided a stint on the DL and is back resuming what has been an outstanding campaign. In seven starts, the young lefty has gone 3-1 with a 3.98 ERA (18 ER / 40.2 IP), second lowest on the team to John Ely’s 3.78 ERA. (Starter Tim Sexton has an ERA of 1.50, but that’s after just one start- 6.0 IP). Most impressive has been Bastardo’s control. In 40.2 innings of work, he has fanned 33, while walking just 13.

ONE RUN WONDERS: Albuquerque’s dominance in one-run games continues. Last night’s 7-6 win gave the ‘Topes a PCL-best record of 11-3 in games decided by the slimmest of margins. They’ve been padding that record this homestand, racking up four one-run wins in their last seven games. Out of 13 total victories this month, eight have been by one run. The ‘Topes’ best record all-time in one-run games is 25-16, set in 2003.

FANTASTIC FINISHES: As if games at Isotopes Park weren’t exciting enough, the ‘Topes have been making a habit this homestand of rewarding their fans with walk-off wins. Since May 19, the Isotopes have had three walk-off wins in the bottom of the ninth. This season, Albuquerque has walked off at home six times.

ANOTHER DAY, ANOTHER SERIES: If the ‘Topes can beat the Sky Sox tonight, they will win their fifth home series out of seven sets played at The Lab so far this year. The only home series the Isotopes have not won this year were a pair of series splits with Omaha on April 7-10 and May 2-5.

FORMER ‘TOPES INFIELDER WITH THE WIN?: Infielder Wilson Valdez, who played for the ‘Topes in 2003 and 2004, earned a rare victory on the mound during last night’s 19th-inning marathon between the Phillies and Reds. With the game tied 4-4 in the top of the 19th, Valdez coaxed three fly-outs around a Scott Rolen hit-by-pitch before the Phillies won it in the bottom half of the 19th on a Raul Ibanez sacrifice fly.

BIG HOMESTAND ROLLS ON!: The ‘Topes continue their eight-game homestand with a day that collectors mark in their calendar each year; the release of the team’s annual baseball card set. This year’s set promises to be the best yet, so be sure to come early.

TODAY'S START: Alberto Bastardo makes the start after skipping a turn to tend to a sore lower back. In his last outing on May 15 at Tucson, Bastardo pitched seven strong innings, allowign three runs on seven hits while walking one and striking out five in a 10-5 'Topes win, the lefty's third of the season. Suffered his first loss of the season on May 10 at Las Vegas, when he allowed five runs, two earned, on six hits in six innings of work in a 7-0 loss. Earned his second win of the season and second consecutive victory on April 29 in which he out-pitched 2009 Cy Young Award winner Zack Greinke, who was making a rehab assignment for the Nashville Sounds. Bastardo allowed just one run on five hits in 7.1 innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-1 'Topes win over the Sounds. Got his first win of the season on April 23 against New Orleans at Isotopes Park when he pitched six innings, allowing four runs on nine hits whie walking none and striking out seven in a 12-8 'Topes win.

2010: Split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 12-8 with a 5.68 ERA in 27 starts... tied for the Dodger organizational lead with 12 wins and 27 starts... won the May Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga, going 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/31.2 IP) in five starts in the month... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of May 17-23, going 2-0 and allowing only an unearned run with 14 strikeouts in 14.0 innings in his two starts... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on May 17 at Mobile before giving up a one-out single... ended up pitching seven shutout innings, giving up the one hit while walking two and striking out seven in a 7-0 Lookouts win... transferred to Albuquerque on June 10 and won three straight decisions... transferred back to Chattanooga on August 13 and finished the year in Chattanooga... following the season, played for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Winter League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Saw action in 2009 at three levels of Dodgers system, starting in Single-A Inland Empire, stoppnig at Double-A Chattanooga and ending the season with an appearance at Triple-A Albuquerque... combined to go 12-5 with a 4.01 ERA (66 ER / 148.1 IP) in all three stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA (32 ER / 75.0 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... selected to the California League Mid-Season All-Star team on June 23... transferred to Chattanooga on June 25 and went 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA (34 ER / 72.1 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... tossed a complete-game on August 5 vs. West Tenn., allowing two runs on three hits in nine innings while striking out eight... transferred to Albuquerque on September 6 and made a relief appearance in the last game of the regular season at Iowa on September 7, firing a scoreless inning... was on the Isotopes' playoff roster and was slated to start game four of the first round but did not pitch as the 'Topes were swept in three games.

Spent the entire 2008 season with Single-A Inland Empire of the California League, going 5-8 with a 5.19 ERA (76 ER / 131.2 IP) in 30 appearances (21 starts)... went 5-8 with a 4.70 ERA (55 ER / 105.1 IP) in 21 starts and 0-0 with a 7.18 ERA (21 ER / 26.1 IP) in nine relief appearances.
