ISOTOPES SURGE PAST SOX, 5-4: It was another night, another close game, and another victory for the Albuquerque Isotopes as they pulled out a 5-4 win over the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on Thursday night at Isotopes Park. The Isotopes trailed 4-3 in the bottom of the eighth when Jamie Hoffmann hit a one-out single to left field. Two batters later, J.D. Closser came up to bat and clobbered an 0-2 pitch from former Isotope Eric Stults over the scoreboard in left-center to give Albuquerque a 5-4 lead. In the ninth inning, Jon Link came on to replace reliever Mario Alvarez and whirled through the Sky Sox, 1-2-3, collecting a pair of strikeouts along the way to clinching another one-run 'Topes win. Much of Thursday's scoring came in the earlier stages of the game, with Colorado Springs taking an early 2-0 lead in the top of the first on the strength of a two-run homer by Mike Jacobs. Albuquerque halved the Sky Sox advantage in its half of the first before knotting the contest in the bottom of the second on an RBI single by Dee Gordon. Colorado Springs jumped back ahead in the top of the fourth inning, however, thanks to an RBI groundout by Rademes Nazario and a fielding error by the Isotopes third baseman Casey Blake, which allowed Jeff Salazar to come home from third and push the visitors' lead to 4-2. But the 'Topes got within one run again immediately in their half of the fourth, as Gordon hit a sacrifice fly after an epic 11-pitch at-bat with no one out and the bases loaded that scored Closser to make it 4-3. Sox. It stayed that way until the bottom of the eighth – and Closser's monster shot that would give Albuquerque a come-from-behind win.

A COMPLETE PITCHER: Right-hander John Ely has established himself this season as a guy who likes to finish what he's started. Both of his wins this year have been complete games, with a seven-inning complete-game shutout on April 20 at Iowa in the second game of doubleheader and a three-hit masterpiece in his last outing on May 22 vs. Reno. In that outing, Ely pitched the first nine-inning complete-game of his career and just the 10th thrown by an Isotope at home while holding the Aces to one run (on a Cody Ransom home run) on three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 win. There are four pitching performances this year in the Pacific Coast League in which the starter has allowed three hits or less and Ely has two of them. Aside from the right-hander's one-hit shutout on April 20 and his three-hitter last time out, Mike McDonald from Las Vegas allowed Fresno two hits in a 7-0 win on April 16 and Reno's Matt Torra tossed a two-hitter in the first game of a doubleheader on May 9 vs. Salt Lake.

BIG SERIES IN THE BIG EASY: Albuquerque makes its first visit to New Orleans in 2011 for a series that is rife with divisional intrigue. Both teams are nipping at the heels of the Round Rock Express in the PCL's American Southern Division, with the 'Topes just a half a game back and the Z's 2.5 games behind. Not only do the Isotopes enter the series with some overall momentum as winners of six of their last eight, they also have won six of their last eight games against the Zephyrs dating back to last year, including three of four at Isotopes Park earlier this year. All-time, the 'Topes are 30-32 in the Crescent City.

HEAD OF THE CLOSS: J.D. Closser continues to swing an absolutely scorching bat, collecting hits in his last eight games, a span in which he's batted .440 (11x25) with nine runs and an astonishing 14 RBI. He's twice advanced his streak with pinch-hit knocks and since May 16 has homered in five of the seven games he's played.

HIGH WATER: With a record of 27-19 entering tonight's game, the Isotopes are eight games above .500 for the first time all season. In their last 13 games, the 'Topes are 9-4.

LONG AND WINDING ROAD: Today is the first of a 12-game road trip for the Isotopes, their longest sojourn away from Isotopes Park this season. After four games in New Orleans, Albuquerque will play four in Memphis before wrapping things up with a four-game series against division-leading Round Rock, in what will be the rivals' first meeting of 2011. The long road trip is the perfect opportunity to turn around Albuquerque's 8-10 record on the

TODAY'S START: Right-hander John Ely makes his first start since a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Enjoyed a breakout 2009 season in his first year at Double-A with Birmingham in the Chicago White Sox organization, going 14-2 with a 2.82 ERA (49 ER / 156.1 IP) in 27 starts... tied for first in the Southern League with 14 wins and was first in strikeouts with 125... traded from the White Sox with right-hander Jon Link for outfielder Juan Pierre on December 18.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/ Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game... selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
