ALBUQUERQUE FALLS TO Z'S, 6-3: After winning six of eight games in their latest homestand, the Albuquerque Isotopes found the PCL road a little more inhospitable, falling to the New Orleans Zephyrs 6-3 in the first game of their series Friday night at Zephyr Field. Coming off a dominant three-hit, complete game gem in his last start, Isotopes right-hander John Ely struggled out of the gate, loading the bases in the bottom of the first for Matt Dominguez, who drew a two-out free pass that plated a run and put the Zephyrs up 1-0 after one. New Orleans kept coming in the bottom of the second, when Oscar Salazar led off the frame with a triple, and immediately scored on an RBI single by Z's starting pitcher Sean West to put the home team ahead 2-0. The Zephyrs capped the inning with a run coming in on a double-play to increase the advantage to 3-0. Albuquerque finally got on the board in the top of the third, thanks to the dynamic duo of Ivan De Jesus and Eugenio Velez. After De Jesus roped a two-out single, Velez picked him up with a double deep to center that helped the Isotopes trim the lead to 3-1. The Z's would respond emphatically and immediately in the bottom of the third, however, plating three runs to seize control of the game and a 6-1 lead. Albuquerque added one run in the fifth and one last run in the ninth to make it a three-run game, but that's where the rally would stall as New Orleans sealed the 6-3 triumph.

SEXTON LOOKING FOR AN ENCORE: Young right-hander Tim Sexton makes his second career Triple-A start looking to follow up on an excellent Isotopes debut on May 23 against Colorado Springs at Isotopes Park. In that start, Sexton pitched six strong innings, allowing just one run on three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 'Topes win. The 23-year old's only mistake the entire game came in the second inning, when big league veteran Ian Stewart hammered a solo homer to give the Sky Sox a short-lived lead. The only thing that would've made Sexton's night better is if he had gotten the win. Although he left with a 3-1 lead after six, Colorado Springs rallied in the eighth inning to tie the contest at 4-4 before Albuquerque scored the eventual game-winner in the bottom of the eighth.

DE JESUS COMFORTABLE ON THE ROAD: Hotel beds seem to suit Ivan De Jesus Jr. just fine, as the infielder as recorded a hit in each of his four starts away from Isotopes Park this season. Over that span, De Jesus has gone 8-for-20 (.400), including a season-high four hits in last night's game. Since returning from the Dodgers on May 14, De Jesus has batted .326 (14x43) with three runs, three doubles, and six RBI in 13 games.

RUSS RETURNS: Today the Isotopes are expected to be joined by infielder Russ Mitchell, who comes back to the Isotopes after being optioned by the Dodgers yesterday to make room for a healthy Casey Blake. Mitchell was called up on April 29 when Blake went down with a staph infection in his elbow and appeared in 14 games for LA, batting .115 (3x26) with three runs, a double, a homer, and an RBI. On May 20, Mitchell hit his first Major League home run of the season, a dramatic solo shot in the top of the ninth against the Chicago White Sox that tied the game at 3-3 and sent it into extra innings, where the Dodgers prevailed in 10 frames 6-4. Mitchell also made a diving stop at third in the 10th to help preserve the two-run lead. In his last game for Los Angeles on May 24 at Houston, Mitchell recorded his first career big league pinch-hit, a double.

BIG, BUT NOT SO EASY: Dating back to last season, the Isotopes have lost four straight games at Zephyr Field. Albuquerque's last win in New Orleans came in the first game of a doubleheader on August 1, 2010. Since then, the 'Topes have been outscored in the Big Easy 32-9 by the Zephyrs.

HOME SICK: Last night's loss continues a streak of struggling for the Isotopes away from Isotopes Park. In its last 10 games on the road, Albuquerque is 3-7.

TODAY'S START: Tim Sexton takes the mound for his second career Triple-A start after an excellent outing in his debut with the Isotopes on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs when he pitched six strong innings, allowing one run (an Ian Stewart solo homer) on just three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 Albuquerque win.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20.

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played a second full season at Single-A Inland Empire in 2009, going 8-14 with a 3.96 ERA (69 ER / 157.0 IP) in 27 games (22 starts)... tied for the club lead with eight wins and 22 starts... ranked third on the team with a career-high 100 strikeouts... tossed a career-high 157 innings, tops in the Dodger organization and second in the California League... selected to the California League mid-season All-Star Team, posting a 3.21 ERA (27 ER / 75.2 IP) in 13 games (10 starts) before the All-Star break... won the July Dodger Pride Award for Inland Empire, going 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA (14 ER / 36.1 IP) in six July starts... threw 7.0 innings or more in seven of his outings.

Spent the full 2008 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 5-12 with a 6.04 ERA (95 ER / 141.2 IP) in 28 games (26 starts)... struck out 92 while walking 36 in his 141.2 innings... named California League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 14-20 when he went 2-0 with an 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP).

Began his professional career in 2007 with Single-A Great Lakes, going 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP) in five games (no starts)... rated as the 24th best prospect in the Dodger organization and as having the fifth-best pro debut among all Junior College players from the 2007 draft by *Baseball America*.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Timothy Edward Sexton... attended Miami-Dade CC in Florida... selected by the Dodgers in the 25th round of the 2007 draft.
