## ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (42-34) AT IOWA CUBS (35-42)

**'TOPES CLIPPED BY CUBS 4-3:** The Albuquerque Isotopes hit a pair of long balls and built an early 3-0 lead, but couldn't hang on as the Iowa Cubs rallied for a 4-3 series-opening win Saturday night at Principal Park. Things got off to a great start for the visiting Isotopes, who scored a run in the top of the first when Jay Gibbons smashed a two-out, solo homer to right, giving Albuquerque a quick 1-0 lead. Gibbons was right in the middle of the next Isotopes uprising in the third, igniting a rally with a one-out single. That provided a key base-runner for Jerry Sands, who promptly cashed in Gibbons with a two-run homer to left that increased the Albuquerque advantage to 3-0. The three run cushion was not enough, however, as Iowa began chipping away in the bottom of the fourth. After back-to-back walks led off the inning, Ty Wright hammered a two-run double to center, trimming the lead to 3-2 'Topes. Iowa would knot the game one inning later when, with runners on the corners and one down, Brad Snyder laced a single to center, tying the contest at 3-3. The Cubs comeback would be completed in the sixth, as Iowa manufactured the go-ahead run. Scott Moore led off the inning by getting hit by a pitch from Albuquerque reliever David Pfeiffer and was immediately sacrificed into scoring position for Jonathan Mota, who lined a single into center field, plating Moore and giving the home team its first lead of the game at 4-3. A single run advantage proved enough for the Cubs thanks to some solid work on the mound. After allowing the three runs, Iowa starter Ramon Ortiz settled in through six innings of work allowing the three tallies on eight hits while walking one and striking out seven to claim the victory. Ortiz was spelled by relievers Blake Parker and John Gaub, who combined for three shutout innings, allowing just one hit and two walks between the two of them while striking out four to seal the victory.

**A RED-HOT PITCHER:** Looking at lefty Randy Keisler's numbers in the last two weeks or so, you'd think there was some kind of typo. Keisler has won each of his last four outings, compiling an ERA of 0.38 (1 ER / 24.0 IP) in the process. In his last appearance on June 21, the southpaw entered the game in the second inning in relief of Major League rehabbing closer Jonathan Broxton and put up six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most by an Isotopes pitcher this year and the most by a 'Topes hurler in a relief outing in team history. The last time Keisler allowed an earned run was in the third inning of Albuquerque's game with Nashville on June 11, a span of 15.1 straight frames without yielding an earned tally. In the month of June, which includes a pair of relief appearances before he returned to the 'Topes rotation on June 6, Keisler has an ERA of 1.01 (3 ER / 26.2 IP) the second-lowest of the month in the PCL to Omaha's Luis Mendoza, who has a mark of 0.99 (3 ER 27.1 IP) to go along with a 3-0 record this month. Keisler's four wins this month also ranks second in the league to Reno hurler Barry Enright's five.

**UNCHARTED TERRITORY:** For the first time all season, the Isotopes have lost four straight games, their longest losing streak since they dropped four straight on August 9-13 last season. As a result, the 'Topes have also fallen into second place in the PCL's American Southern Division for the first time since June 6, breaking a streak of 19 straight days that Albuquerque has had at least a share of first place.

**SLUGGING SANDS:** Jerry Sands is beginning to show off the power he displayed earlier in the season when he homered in four straight games and ultimately earned a trip to Los Angeles for his Major League debut. With a two-run dinger last night, Sands has homered in each of his last two games and in three of his last four, racking up four total dingers in that span. Sands now has a total of 10 homers on the season, the third Isotope to reach double-digits in dingers behind Trayvon Robinson (17) and Jamie Hoffmann (12).

**MASTERFUL MERKIN:** Thanks to a perfect inning last night in which he struck out the side, reliever Merkin Valdez has now gone 13.2 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run. Over that span he's allowed just seven hits and fanned 19.

**ROAD WEARY:** After Albuquerque seemingly exorcized its road demons by winning five of six at the tail of the Isotopes' 12-game road trip at the beginning of the month, the 'Topes have now dropped four of their last five games away from Isotopes Park.

**TODAY'S START:** Randy Keisler takes the mound having won each of his last four outings, a span in which he's posted a stellar 0.38 ERA (1 ER / 24.0 IP). In his last outing on June 21 vs. Oklahoma City, Keisler came on in the second in relief of the rehabbing Jonathan Broxton and delivered six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most punch-outs by a 'Topes pitcher this year and the most by an Isotopes in a relief appearance in franchise history.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on Jun 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two and striking out 10.

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).

Roped a pinch-hit RBI double on April 18 in an 8-6 win at Oklahoma City.

Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3 and joined the Isotopes as camp broke.

**2010:** Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlantic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings... opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore... went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

Starte the 2006 season at Triple-A Sacramento... won three consecutive starts, going 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER / 18.0 IP) from April 22 to May 2... contract was selected on May 12 and made 11 relief appearances with the A's before being optioned on June 9... had a four-game winning streak from July 4 to August 11... recalled on July 26 and optioned again on July 28... outrighted to Sacramento on August 8.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Randy Dean Keisler... was a 1994 graduate of Palmer (TX) High School after attending Navasota (TX) High School prior to his senior year... attended Louisiana State University and was named to the All-Southeastern Conference College World Series Team as a junior... spent his first two collegiate seasons at Navarro (TX) Junior College... drafted by New York (AL) in the second round of the 1998 draft.
