### ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (42-35) AT IOWA CUBS (36-42)

ISOTOPES FALL TO I-CUBS, 8-3: The Albuquerque Isotopes got a home run from red-hot slugger Jerry Sands but it wasn't enough as the Iowa Cubs countered with three long balls of their own en route to an 8-3 win Sunday afternoon at Principal Park. The I-Cubs struck first in the bottom of the third in a two-out rally capped by their first homer of the afternoon. With two on and two down, Darwin Barney, on loan from the Chicago Cubs on a Major League rehab assignment, smashed a three-run homer deep over the fence in center to give Iowa a sudden 3-0 lead. The Cubs struck again in the third and again with two outs. Jonathan Mota laced a two-out, RBI single to right that increased the Iowa lead to 4-0. In an attempt to pick-off Mota at first, the throw from 'Topes starter Randy Keisler sailed up the right field line, allowing Welington Castillo to score from third and make it 5-0 I-Cubs. Finally, the pitcher Marco Carrillo dumped a single into left that scored Mota and increased the Iowa advantage to 6-0. In addition to his work at the plate, 2-for-2 with an RBI and a run scored, Carrillo was pretty good on the mound as well, shutting out the Isotopes on just two hits through five dominant innings in which he walked none and struck out four to earn his first win of the season. Albuquerque finally got on the board in the seventh, when Sands led off the frame by smashing a solo homer to left that cut the Cubs lead to 6-1. Iowa immediately responded, however, as Bryan LaHair and Castillo connected on back-to-back solo homers to boost the home team's lead to 8-1. The 'Topes did mount one last-gasp rally in the top of the ninth on RBI singles by Russ Mitchell and Corey Smith to trim the lead to 8-3, but it wasn't enough as Cubs reliever Marcos Mateo slammed the door and preserved the Iowa win.

BACK TO THE SCENE OF (NEAR) HISTORY: Right-hander John Ely returns to Principal Park for the first since he came one out away from tossing a no-hitter against the Cubs in the second game of a doubleheader on April 20. In fact, both of Ely's starts this season against Iowa have been notable. In addition to the no-hitter that was broken up with two outs in the bottom of the seventh, Ely came one out away from his PCL-leading third complete game in his last outing against Iowa on June 17 at Isotopes Park, departing in the ninth after giving up back-to-back base hits in an eventual 13-10 Isotopes win. The common denominator in both starts is that Ely prevailed in both, running his record against the I-Cubs this year to 2-0 with a 4.02 ERA (7 ER / 15.2 IP). The right-hander has also fanned 15 while walking just five in those outings against Iowa.

A NOT SO FINE FIVE: With yesterday's defeat, the Isotopes have now lost five straight games, their longest losing streak of the season and their longest skid since they've been affiliated with the Dodgers. The last time Albuquerque had a losing streak of longer than four games was in 2008, when the Isotopes dropped eight straight from June 28 to July 5. The longest losing streak in franchise history is nine games, set in 2004.

SANDS-BLASTING: With another long ball yesterday, Jerry Sands has homered in three straight games, one shy of his team-high of four straight games with a homer that he delivered from April 9 to April 12. Since part of that first streak was also against Iowa in a series at Isotopes Park, Sands has been doing a lot of his damage with the long ball against the Cubs. The slugger has belted four homers in 10 games against Iowa, while driving in a team-high 15 runs against the I-Cubs.

**JUSTIN TIME:** Justin Sellers continues to swing a red-hot bat for the Isotopes, increasing his season-high hitting streak to 10 games, a span in which he's batted .486 (17x35). Sellers has been especially scorching in his last four games, all multiple-hit performances in which he's racked up nine hits in 14 at-bats (.643).

**TGI-MONDAY:** The Isotopes are probably the only people who look forward to Mondays, a day when the 'Topes seem to play their best baseball. This year, Albuquerque is 9-2 on Monday, by far the team's best record on any one day of the week.

TODAY'S START: John Ely takes the mound coming off a hard-luck loss on June

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

22 vs. Oklahoma City at Isotopes Park when he allowed four runs on seven hit in six

innings while walking three and striking out five in a 5-4 'Topes loss.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
