'TOPES LOSE 6-5 HEARTBREAKER IN 15 INNINGS: After nearly five hours of baseball, the Albuquerque Isotopes succumbed to the Iowa Cubs in a gut-wrenching 6-5, 15-inning loss Monday night at Principal Park. Knotted at 5-5 in the top of the 15th, the 'Topes looked poised to take the lead when Russ Mitchell hit a grounder that went through third baseman Jonathan Mota and careened down the left field line for a lead-off, two base error. Mitchell would never leave that second base perch, however, as Trayvon Robinson struck out on a foul bunt, Joe Becker followed with another strikeout, and Damaso Espino grounded out to third, ending the Isotopes threat and sending the game to the bottom of the 15th. Iowa immediately started a rally in the bottom of the frame on a one-out single to left by Marwin Gonzalez. Jonathan Mota then hit a soft grounder to Becker at second, whose throw to try and force Gonzalez out a second was errant, allowing the winning run to reach second safely. Pinch-hitter Chris Robinson then ended the marathon with a single to center, scoring Gonzalez and giving the Cubs a dramatic 6-5 walk-off win. The game wouldn't have even reached extra innings if not for some late inning heroics by the 'Topes. Down 5-4 in the top of the eighth, Jamie Hoffmann crushed a two-out solo homer deep over the wall in center field to knot the game at 5-5. That set up the bullpens, which were masterful for both teams. Merkin Valdez, David Pfeiffer, and Jon Link combined for six shutout innings, allowing just three hits between them while striking out seven. Mario Alvarez (1-2) pitched the 15th and suffered the loss. Iowa, meanwhile, got three shutout innings from Scott Maine and four more from eventual winner John Gaub (3-1). The two Cubs pitchers combined for 14 strikeouts in seven innings of work, fanning seven batters apiece.

SEXTON BACK ON TRACK: After enduring a rough outing in an appearance against Iowa on June 18 at Isotopes Park, right-hander Tim Sexton displayed his resiliency, bouncing back in his last outing on June 23 vs. Oklahoma City and pitching a gem that resulted in a tough-luck no decision. After entering the game in the second in relief of Dodgers rehabbing closer Jonathan Broxton, Sexton tossed six solid frames, allowing just two runs, one earned, on six hits while walking one and striking out four. The right-hander departed with a 3-2 lead and should've picked up his fourth win of the season, but the RedHawks erupted for five runs in the eighth on their way to an 8-6 win. Today, the right-hander looks to also continue his solid showings on the road. Sexton has won each of his last three starts away from Isotopes Park and has posted a 3.74 ERA (9 ER / 21.2 IP) in four road starts this season.

AVOID THE BROOM: The Isotopes take the field today looking to avoid their first four-game series sweep since August 3-6, 2008, (when Albuquerque lost four in a row at Tacoma), their second sweep to the Cubs in franchise history, and their first sweep at Principal Park. Albuquerque's season-long losing streak has now reached six games,

MARATHON MEN: Last night's 15-inning marathon shouldn't come as too much of a surprise, since the I-Cubs and 'Topes have had a history of long games. Albuquerque's longest game of 2010 was a 14-inning contest at Iowa on June 19 and the Isotopes' longest game in franchise history, a 17-inning epic, came against the I-Cubs at Isotopes Park on July 16, 2006. Last night's game lasted 4:52 and featured 11 pitchers who combined to throw 468 pitches.

GENO-ME PROJECT: With hits in 11 of his last 12 games, Eugenio Velez continues to be a difficult out. Since June 16, Velez is batting .375 (21x56), racking up six multi-hit games in that span. Of course, this latest hot flash is a mere continuation of scorching month, as Velez is batting .345 (39x113) with 21 runs in 26 games.

A FINE FOURTH IS COMING UP: After a road trip through the midwest, the 'Topes are back home next Monday for a spectacular Fourth of July celebration. After the game, fans will be treated to the biggest and best fireworks show in town, courtesy of First Community Bank. Gates open at 5:30 pm so fans can stake out a great spot early!

TODAY'S START: Tim Sexton makes the start after a tough no-decision on June 23 vs. Oklahoma City. After coming into the game in the second inning in relief of Dodgers rehabbing closer Jonathan Broxton, Sexton tossed six strong innings, allowing just two runs, one earned, on six hits while walking one and striking out four. The right-hander was in line to get the win, departing with a 3-2 lead, but the RedHawks plated five in the eighth en route to an 8-6 win.

Won his third straight start on June 13 at Oklahoma City when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs no eight hits while walking one and striking out two in a 4-3 'Topes win. Earned his first career Triple-A win, a 5-4 triumph at Memphis on June 2 when he allowed two runs on six hits in five innings while walking two and striking out three.

Enjoyed an excellent outing in his debut with the Isotopes on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs when he pitched six strong innings, allowing one run (an Ian Stewart solo homer) on just three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 Albuquerque win.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20.

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played a second full season at Single-A Inland Empire in 2009, going 8-14 with a 3.96 ERA (69 ER / 157.0 IP) in 27 games (22 starts)... tied for the club lead with eight wins and 22 starts... ranked third on the team with a career-high 100 strikeouts... tossed a career-high 157 innings, tops in the Dodger organization and second in the California League... selected to the California League mid-season All-Star Team, posting a 3.21 ERA (27 ER / 75.2 IP) in 13 games (10 starts) before the All-Star break... won the July Dodger Pride Award for Inland Empire, going 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA (14 ER / 36.1 IP) in six July starts... threw 7.0 innings or more in seven of his outings.

Spent the full 2008 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 5-12 with a 6.04 ERA (95 ER / 141.2 IP) in 28 games (26 starts)... struck out 92 while walking 36 in his 141.2 innings... named California League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 14-20 when he went 2-0 with an 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP).

Began his professional career in 2007 with Single-A Great Lakes, going 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP) in five games (no starts)... rated as the 24th best prospect in the Dodger organization and as having the fifth-best pro debut among all Junior College players from the 2007 draft by *Baseball America*.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Timothy Edward Sexton... attended Miami-Dade CC in Florida... selected by the Dodgers in the 25th round of the 2007 draft.
