ZEPHYRS TOP 'TOPES, 9-5: The Albuquerque Isotopes tried but could not dig out of an early hole as the New Orleans Zephyrs took the final game of their four-game series, 9-5, on Monday afternoon at Isotopes Park. New Orleans cracked the scoreboard first with a three-run burst in the third inning. With runners on first and second and one away, Jose Lopez singled to right-center to score Vinny Rottino for a 1-0 Zephyr lead. That brought up Mike Cervenak, who laced a triple to right-center field that plated two more runs, making it 3-0, Z's. New Orleans then delivered a four-run blow to the 'Topes in the fourth inning. Following a lead-off single from Ozzie Martinez, Tim Torres homered to left-center to give the Zephyrs a 5-0 edge. Three batters later, Lopez struck again with a two-run homer, pushing the Z's lead to 7-0. The visitors would tack on one more run in the top of the fifth via a bases-loaded walk from relief pitcher Adam Dedeaux for an 8-0 advantage. Albuquerque finally got on the board in their half of the fifth inning. After Trayvon Robinson was hit by a pitch to lead off the inning, Jamie Hoffmann followed with a walk, setting up A.J. Ellis, who ripped a three-run shot, his second homer in four days, to bring the Isotopes to within 8-3. The 'Topes continued to climb back into the game in the seventh inning. With runners on the corners and two down, Justin Sellers hammered a double into the gap in left-center plating both base runners and bringing Albuquerque all the way back to within just three runs at 8-5. In the ninth, New Orleans tacked on one final run of insurance on a solo homer from Cervenak that would be the final scoring of the afternoon in a 9-5 Zephyrs win.

KEISLER ON THE HILL: Lefty Randy Keisler takes the mound looking to snap a two-game road losing streak while also exacting some revenge on the Omaha Storm Chasers. In his last visit to Werner Park on July 2, Keisler allowed four runs, three of them earned, on eight hits in seven strong innings while walking three and striking out two, but ended up on the losing end of a 4-1 decision. That is the last time Keisler has suffered defeat, as the lefty has won his last two home starts, sandwiching a no-decision at Nashville on July 15. Keisler's last win away from Isotopes Park came at Oklahoma City on June 16, when he dominated the RedHawks, allowing one run on four hits in seven innings of an 8-2 'Topes win.

BACK TO NEBRASKA: For second time this month, and for the last time in 2011, the Isotopes are making the trip to Omaha and Werner Park to face the Omaha Storm Chasers. Albuquerque arrives in Nebraska looking for better results after nearly being swept during its last visit on June 30-July 3. After losing the first three games, which also came on the tail end of the team's franchise-record 10-game losing streak, the 'Topes shut out the Chasers 2-0 to avoid the sweep. The 'Topes come in with some momentum, having won their last three games away from Isotopes on July 15-17 at Nashville.

HOME RUN ELLIS: After waiting since August, 2008 for a home run, A.J. Ellis waited all of four days for another, as the catcher blasted his second home of the season in yesterday's contest with New Orleans. Ellis has now hit in eight of last nine Triple-A games, batting a scorching .483 (15x31) in that span with 11 runs, four doubles, two homers, and 15 RBI. He's also increased his consecutive on-base streak to 31 games, fifth longest in the PCL this season.

NEXT HOMESTAND BECKONS: After eight days on the road, the 'Topes are back in town next Wednesday, August 3 for an eight-game homestand that kicks off the final month of the regular season in style. The fun starts a Lunch Bag giveaway on August 4 courtesy of Webster University, and continues with an Orbit Bank giveaway on Friday, August 5 courtesy of U.S. Bank and a post-game fireworks show on Saturday, August 6.

TODAY'S START: Lefty Randy Keisler takes the mound coming off his sixth win of the season in the first game of a doubleheader on July 21 vs. Oklahoma City, when he pitched 5.1 innings, allowing four runs on seven hits while walking three and fanning three in an 8-4 'Topes triumph.

Won four straight outings from June 6 to June 21, a span in which he posted a stellar 0.38 ERA (1 ER / 24.0 IP). On June 21 vs. Oklahoma City, Keisler came on in the second in relief of the rehabbing Jonathan Broxton and delivered six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most punch-outs by a 'Topes pitcher this year and the most by an Isotope in a relief appearance in franchise history.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on June 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two and striking out 10.

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).

Roped a pinch-hit RBI double on April 18 in an 8-6 win at Oklahoma City.

Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3 and joined the Isotopes as camp broke.

2010: Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlantic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independnet Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings... opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore... went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

Starte the 2006 season at Triple-A Sacramento... won three consecutive starts, going 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER / 18.0 IP) from April 22 to May 2... contract was selected on May 12 and made 11 relief appearances with the A's before being optioned on June 9... had a four-game winning streak from July 4 to August 11... recalled on July 26 and optioned again on July 28... outrighted to Sacramento on August 8.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Randy Dean Keisler... was a 1994 graduate of Palmer (TX) High School after attending Navasota (TX) High School prior to his senior year... attended Louisiana State University and was named to the All-Southeastern Conference College World Series Team as a junior... spent his first two collegiate seasons at Navarro (TX) Junior College... drafted by New York (AL) in the second round of the 1998 draft.
