ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (68-69) AT MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (73-63)

ISOTOPES NIPPED BY 'BIRDS, 3-1: The Albuquerque Isotopes found themselves embroiled in a pitcher's duel and were only able to muster three base hits, as the Memphis Redbirds eked out a 3-1 series-opening win Monday night at AutoZone Park. In a game where runs were at a premium, the 'Topes struck first, plating a tally in the top of the third. Ivan De Jesus Jr. led off the inning with a single and was in danger of being stranded there until Jerry Sands kept the rally going with a two-out walk. That put a runner in scoring position for Jamie Hoffmann, who dropped a single to right, scoring De Jesus and giving Albuquerque an early 1-0 edge. Tim Federowicz drew another walk to load the bases, but Memphis starter Adam Ottavino coaxed a groundout to avoid further damage. Leaving the bases loaded proved costly for the 'Topes, as Memphis responded with a run in the bottom of the frame. Adron Chambers started the rally with a lead-off triple and immediately scored on a sacrifice fly by Shane Robinson, knotting the game at 1-1. Memphis surged ahead in the seventh on Albuquerque reliever Ramon Troncoso. Robinson led off the inning with a single and was immediately sacrificed to second on a bunt, putting the go-ahead run in scoring position. A pick-off attempt by Troncoso at second sailed errant, allowing Robinson to coast into third, from where he scored on a Mark Hamilton single to give the home team a 2-1 lead. The 'Birds tacked on one more run in the eighth, thanks in part to another 'Topes miscue. With one down, Pete Kozma reached on a fielding error by Albuquerque first baseman Russ Mitchell, and then swiped second base. Nick Stavinoha then roped a double to left, scoring Kozma and propelling Memphis to a 3-1 win.

HOMECOMING FOR PARISI: Mike Parisi makes his return to AutoZone Park, which served as his home ballpark for the majority of the 2007 and 2008 seasons. The right-hander also returns to his former haunt on a roll, with wins in his last four decisions. Since August 3, Parisi has been the Isotopes' best starting pitcher, going 4-0 with a 4.17 ERA (15 ER / 32.1 IP) over his last five outings. It really should be a five-game winning streak, as the right-hander ended up with a no-decision in his best outing of the streak. On August 20 against his former team the Redbirds at Isotopes Park, Parisi allowed just one run on five hits through 6.2 innings while walking three and striking out a season-high eight. He left the game with a 2-1 lead and watched the advantage swell to 4-1 before the 'Birds scored four in the ninth to grab a 5-4 edge until Ivan De Jesus won it with a two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth, sending Albuquerque to a 6-5 triumph. Whereas homers were an issue in his first few appearances with the 'Topes (he surrendered seven in his first four starts), Parisi has also been good of late keeping the ball in the yard, allowing just one long ball in his last three outings over 19.1 innings.

LEADING OFF STRONG: Since being moved up from his usual second position in the line-up to the lead-off slot, Ivan De Jesus Jr. has been excellent. In 10 games leading off, De Jesus has batted. 442 (19x43) with 13 runs, a double, a triple, and 10 RBI. Three of his total eight homers on the season have also come batting first, while his on-base percentage out of the one-hole is .500.

CHANNELING HIS INNER A.J.: Catcher A.J. Ellis is currently with the Dodgers, but Tim Federowicz has stepped right in to the veteran catcher's shoes, especially when it comes to working walks. After walking just five times in his first 17 games with the Isotopes, Federowicz has drawn six walks in his last four contests. His on-base percentage for the season over that span has gone from .397 to an Ellis-like .452.

SEEING RED-BIRDS: With last night's loss, the Isotopes have dropped four straight games to the Memphis Redbirds, their longest losing streak to the 'Birds since they lost a franchise-high five to Memphis from June 10 to June 23, 2006. With a season-record of 6-7, the Isotopes are trying to avoid back-to-back losing seasons against the Redbirds for the first time in team history (Albuquerque went 7-9 vs. Memphis last year).

SEE YOU AT THE CHAMPIONSHIP: While the Isotopes home schedule is finished, it doesn't mean there won't be more baseball at Isotopes Park in 2011. On Tuesday, September 20, Isotopes Park will be the site of the Triple-A National Championship Game, pitting the playoff champion of the Pacific Coast League against the playoff champion of the International League. The game is merely the centerpiece of an entire day of fun, including a pre-game autograph session with Dodgers legends Steve Garvey, Ron Cey, and Bill Russell, a fleece blanket giveaway courtesy of Sandia Resort, and a post-game fireworks show!

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Mike Parisi takes the mound riding a four-game winning streak after earning the victory in his last start vs. Round Rock at Isotopes Park on August 25 when he allowed three runs on four hits in 6.2 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 13-3 Isotopes win.

Had his best outing of the season, a no-decision vs. Memphis, on August 20 when he pitched 6.2 innings, allowing just one run on five hits while walking three and striking out a season-high eight. Left the game with a 2-1 lead, but the Redbirds scored four in the ninth to take a 5-4 advantage before Ivan De Jesus won it with a two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth, sending Albuquerque to a 6-5 triumph.

Earned a win in his Isotopes debut on July 23 at Isotopes Park when he allowed the New Orleans Zephyrs five runs on five hits, three of them homers, in five innings while walking four and striking out one in an 11-10 Isotopes win.

Signed from the Long Island Ducks of the independent Atlantic League on July 20.

Went 6-4 with a 3.50 ERA (31 ER / 79.2 IP) in 13 games (all starts) with the Ducks, including a shutout, authored on June 15 at Lancaster when allowed just four hits over nine scoreless innings while walking two and striking out nine in a 6-0 Long Island win.

Selected to the Atlantic League All-Star team and pitched a perfect second inning in the Atlantic League All-Star Game on July 13 at York, PA.

Struck out a season-high 10 in seven innings in a 3-1 win vs. Southern Maryland on May 11, while allowing one run on four hits and two walks.

2010: Selected by the Cubs from St. Louis in the Major League portion of the Rule 5 Draft on December 10, 2009 and spent an injury-plagued season in the Cubs organization. Started the season at Triple-A Iowa, going 0-3 with a 8.50 ERA (17 ER / 18.0 IP) before being transferred to Double-A Tennessee, where he appeared in one game, allowing one run on three hits in 2.2 innings. Diagnosed with bone chips in his right shoulder and had season-ending surgery in May.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Limited to just five outings in 2009 while recovering from Tommy John surgery... went 0-2 with 4.70 ERA (8 ER / 15.1 IP) in stops between the Gulf Coast League Cardinals and the Single-A Palm Beach Cardinals... posted a 1.17 ERA (1 ER /7.2 IP) with a 0-1 record, nine strikeouts and a 0.83 average against (2x24) in three starts with the GCL Cardinals... joined Palm Beach on August 28, going 0-1 with an 8.22 ERA (7 ER / 7.2 IP) in two starts... played for the Surprise Rafters of the Arizona Fall League, going 3-2 with a 4.44 ERA (13 ER / 26.1 IP) with 15 strikeouts and a .257 average against

Made his Major League debut in two stints with the St. Louis Cardinals in 2008... posted an 8.22 ERA (21 ER / 23.0 IP) in 12 appearances (two starts) in two stints with the Cardinals... made his Major League debut on May 5 at Colorado, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings... went 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA (36 ER / 84.0 IP) in 15 starts with Triple-A Memphis... had seasonending Tommy John surgery on August 20.

Spent the majority of the 2007 in Triple-A Memphis, setting career-highs in starts (28) and innings-pitched (165.0) in his first action at the Triple-A level... was 8-13 with a 4.91 ERA (90 ER / 165.0 IP) for the Redbirds... opened the season with a three-game winning streak, April 10-30, going 3-0 with a .10 ERA (9 ER / 19.1 IP) during that span (four games)... held the opposition to a .247 batting average (19x77) with runners in scoring position and two outs... had a 3.62 ERA (32 ER / 79.2 IP) in 13 starts at AutoZone Park... tossed 6.0 or more innings in 18 of his 28 starts, including eight straight from May 21 to June 27.

After being selected by the Cardinals in the ninth round of the 2004 draft, made his professional debut by going a combned 5-3 with a 3.88 ERA (31 ER / 72.0 IP) in 13 starts with Single-A New Jersey and Single-A Peoria.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Michael Richard Parisi... attended Manhattan College in New York and pitched for the Jaspers from 2002-2004... went to Sachem High School in Lake Ronkonkoma, New York... he and his fiancee Leah plan to get married this fall.
