## ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (69-69) AT MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (73-64)

**PARISI PROPELS ISOTOPES TO 7-3 WIN:** The Albuquerque Isotopes got six superb innings from starter Mike Parisi to help defeat the Memphis Redbirds 7-3 Tuesday night at AutoZone Park. Albuquerque seized a quick lead in the top of the first when Ivan De Jesus Jr. led off the game with a walk, stole second base, and scored on a two-out double by Russ Mitchell to give the 'Topes a quick 1-0 lead. Memphis immediately answered with three of its own in the bottom of the frame to take a 3-1 lead, but that was all Parisi would allow, as the right-hander settled in to deliver a gem. Through six innings of work, he allowed three runs on four hits and three walks while striking out six. From the second inning through the sixth, Parisi (6-1) allowed just three base runners en route to his fifth straight win and sixth of the year. The 'Topes knotted the game in the second when Jamie Hoffmann and Kyle Russell led off the inning with back-to-back singles, putting runners on the corners for Damaso Espino, who plated Hoffmann with a groundout first, trimming the Redbirds lead to 3-2. De Jesus then knocked in Russell with an RBI single, tying the game at 3-3. Albuquerque took the momentum from the second into the third and grabbed the lead for good. Mitchell snapped the deadlock with a one-out solo homer, giving the 'Topes a quick 4-3 lead. After Jerry Sands was hit by a pitch and Hoffmann added another single, Russell was walked, loading the bases for Espino, who drew another free pass, plating Sands and increasing the advantage to 5-3, Isotopes. Pitcher Parisi then hit a grounder in the direction of third base that got past Matt Carpenter for an error, allowing Hoffmann and Russell to score and put Albuquerque ahead 7-3. That was more than enough for Parisi, who cruised through six innings before handing off to relievers Roman Colon, David Pfeiffer, and Jon Link, who authored a perfect frame apiece, striking out a total of four to send the Isotopes to a 7-3 win.

**ON THE ROAD WITH KEISLER:** Due a short stint on the DL with a strained hamstring, left-hander Randy Keisler tonight will be making his first start away from Isotopes Park this month after four straight starts at home. Unlike with most pitchers, Keisler has pitched better in the hitter-friendly environs of Isotopes Park, going 5-3 with a 4.53 ERA (27 ER / 53.2 IP) at home and 2-4 with a 5.48 ERA (28 ER / 46.0 IP) on the road. Keisler's last road victory came back on June 21 at Oklahoma City when he tossed 5.1 innings, allowing one unearned run on six hits while walking three and striking out two in an 8-2 Isotopes win. Since that win, the left-hander has gone 0-3 away from the Duke City and 4-3 at home.

**ALL ABOUT IVAN:** Ivan De Jesus Jr. continues to be lights-out at the plate, racking up hits in his last six games and in 16 of his last 17 contests. Since August 25, the infielder is batting .480 (12x25) with 10 runs, a triple, two homers, and nine RBI. While a lot of players wear down as the season progresses, De Jesus has gotten stronger. Since July 1, he's batting .333 (63x189) and he's easily enjoying his best month in August, batting .346 (37x107) with 27 runs and 23 RBI in 28 games.

**GREAT STARTS:** In their six games, Isotopes starting pitchers have been excellent, going 4-1 with a 3.65 ERA (15 ER / 37.0 IP) since August 25. Last night's winner Mike Parisi has been leading the charge for the rotation, with two victories in that span. Alberto Bastardo and tonight's starter Randy Keisler also have a win apiece since August 25.

**WALK THIS WAY:** With seven walks last night, the Isotopes have now drawn 545 free passes on the season, setting a new franchise record. Prior to this year, the most walks an Isotopes team had ever drawn was 541 back in 2004. Albuquerque currently ranks sixth in the Pacific Coast League in walks by a team, with Reno leading the way by drawing 611 bases-on-balls in 2011.

**SEE YOU AT THE CHAMPIONSHIP:** While the Isotopes home schedule is finished, it doesn't mean there won't be more baseball at Isotopes Park in 2011. On Tuesday, September 20, Isotopes Park will be the site of the Triple-A National Championship Game, pitting the playoff champion of the Pacific Coast League against the playoff champion of the International League. The game is merely the centerpiece of an entire day of fun, including a pre-game autograph session with Dodgers legends Steve Garvey, Ron Cey, and Bill Russell, a fleece blanket giveaway courtesy of Sandia Resort, and a post-game fireworks show!

**TODAY'S START:** Randy Keisler makes the start coming off a brilliant start on August 26 vs. Round Rock when he tossed seven shutout innings, allowing just three hits and a walk while striking out eight in a 9-0 'Topes win.

Placed on the DL on August 12 (retroactive to August 11) with a strained right hamstring suffered in a start on August 10 vs. Salt Lake at Isotopes Park. In the fourth inning of that contest, Keisler went to field a slow roller off the bat of Bees outfielder Jeremy Moore and strained his hamstring, forcing him from the game after pitching three-plus innings in which he allowed four runs on four hits while walking two and striking out three in a 10-7 'Topes loss, Keisler's third in as many starts. Reinstated from the DL on August 21.

Won four straight outings from June 6 to June 21, a span in which he posted a stellar 0.38 ERA (1 ER / 24.0 IP). On June 21 vs. Oklahoma City, Keisler came on in the second in relief of the rehabbing Jonathan Broxton and delivered six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most punch-outs by a 'Topes pitcher this year and the most by an Isotope in a relief appearance in franchise history.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on June 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two and striking out 10.

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).

Roped a pinch-hit RBI double on April 18 in an 8-6 win at Oklahoma City.

Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3 and joined the Isotopes as camp broke.

**2010:** Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlantic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings... opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore... went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Randy Dean Keisler... was a 1994 graduate of Palmer (TX) High School after attending Navasota (TX) High School prior to his senior year... attended Louisiana State University and was named to the All-Southeastern Conference College World Series Team as a junior... spent his first two collegiate seasons at Navarro (TX) Junior College... drafted by New York (AL) in the second round of the 1998 draft.
