ISOTOPES RIPPED BY REDBIRDS, 6-2: The Albuquerque Isotopes conducted a late, ninth-inning rally that came up short as the Memphis Redbirds held on for a 6-2, series-ending win Thursday night at AutoZone Park. Trailing 6-0 and down to their last at-bat, the 'Topes came to life in the ninth when Kyle Russell led off the inning with a double. Pinch-hitter Bryant Hernandez, making his Triple-A debut, then roped a single to center in his first Triple-A at-bat, putting runners on the corners for Ivan De Jesus Jr., who smashed a double to center that cleared the bases and brought the Isotopes back to within 6-2. After a groundout moved De Jesus to third, Jay Gibbons drew a one-out walk, putting the tying run on-deck. The comeback was not to be, however, as Memphis closer Victor Marte came on and struck out Jerry Sands to seal the 6-2 Redbirds win.

ELY RULES THE ROAD: John Ely makes his last start as an Isotope this season looking to continue his recent dominance away from Isotopes Park. In his last five road starts dating back to July 3, the right-hander is 3-0 with a 2.29 ERA (8 ER / 31.1 IP). Over that span, he's also fanned 17, walked 12, and allowed just two home runs. Ely's last loss on the road came all the way back on June 1, when he dropped a decision at Memphis. On the season, Ely is 4-3 with a 4.33 ERA (34 ER / 70.2 IP) in 12 starts on the road and 3-4 with a 7.34 ERA (56 ER / 68.2 IP) in 12 starts in the Duke City.

WRAPPING IT UP IN ROUND ROCK: For the second straight year, the Isotopes will close out the regular season with a four-game Labor Day holiday series in Round Rock, Texas. Last year, the circumstances were much different for the 'Topes, who came into the set trailing Oklahoma by two games in the division and were eliminated with back-to-back series-opening losses to Round Rock before rebounding with two wins to close out the year. In their previous visit to The Dell Diamond this year, Albuquerque took three of four from the Express from June 4-7 and, with an overall mark against Round Rock of 8-4, the 'Topes look to finish with a winning record against the Express for the second straight year (last year Albuquerque was 9-7 vs. Round Rock).

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: The Isotopes have benefited from quality starts in each of the last four games and in seven of their last eight. On the current road trip, 'Topes starters have posted a 2.25 ERA (6 ER / 24.0 IP) while allowing just 18 total hits and striking out 24. Since August 25, Albuquerque starters have lowered their ERA on the year from 6.11 (468 ER / 689.2 IP) to 5.91 (485 ER / 738.2) coming into today's action.

SANDS DRIVES THE TRAIN: No one is happier to see Round Rock again than Jerry Sands, who has torched Express pitching to the tune of a .543 average (19x35) with 14 runs, four doubles, a triple, five homers, and 19 RBI in just eight games. In the Isotopes' just-completed five game set with the E-Train in Albuquerque last week, Sands racked up 12 hits in 22 at-bats (a .545 average) with five runs, two doubles, 11 RBI and three homers, including a grand slam.

WELCOME HOME LONGHORN: Outfielder Kyle Russell this series will play his first games as a professional in Austin, Texas, where he starred as member of the University of Texas baseball team from 2006-08. Russell left the Longhorns as the school's all-time home run leader with 57 (surpassing Jeff Ontiveros, who hit 55 from 1999-2002) and in 2008, he batted .296 with 19 homers and 56 RBI in 57 games to earn All-Big 12 Honorable Mention accolades. In 2007, he led the NCAA with 28 homers and was named a first-team College All-American by Baseball America, first-team Louisville Slugger All-American, and Big 12 Player of the Year.

SEE YOU AT THE CHAMPIONSHIP: While the Isotopes home schedule is finished, it doesn't mean there won't be more baseball at Isotopes Park in 2011. On Tuesday, September 20, Isotopes Park will be the site of the Triple-A National Championship Game, pitting the playoff champion of the Pacific Coast League against the playoff champion of the International League. The game is merely the centerpiece of an entire day of fun, including a pre-game autograph session with Dodgers legends Steve Garvey, Ron Cey, and Bill Russell, a fleece blanket giveaway courtesy of Sandia Resort, and a post-game fireworks show!

TODAY'S START: Righty John Ely makes his last start for the Isotopes this season looking to break a two-game losing streak after falling in a game to the Express on August 28 at Isotopes Park. In that outing, Ely allowed seven runs on eight hits in five inning while walking one and striking out one in a 7-6 loss that shortened to eight innings due to lightning.

Had a short stay with the Dodgers after being recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games. Optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7.

Won three straight starts from July 3 to July 17, posting a 1.89 ERA (4 ER / 19.0 IP) in that span.

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely had dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game.
