'TOPES WIN FIFTH STRAIGHT WITH 6-1 VICTORY OVER REDHAWKS: The Albuquerque Isotopes got two home runs from Alex Castellanos and a masterful performance by starting pitcher Michael Antonini to cruise to a 6-1 series-opening win against the Oklahoma City RedHawks Saturday night at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Albuquerque jumped on the 'Hawks quickly, scoring a run in the top of the first when Castellanos lined a solo homer over the wall in left to put the 'Topes on top 1-0. The RedHawks answered with a run in the bottom of the first to temporarily tie the game at 1-1, but the Isotopes seized the advantage right back with a four-spot in the third. Once again, it was Castellanos who ignited the rally, blasting a towering one-out solo homer to left, his second in as many at-bats, to give the visitors a 2-1 lead. Oklahoma-native Josh Fields then roped an RBI double to right to extend the edge to 3-1. With two outs and runners on the corners, Tim Federowicz hammered a double off the wall in center, increasing the lead to 5-1, Albuquerque. For good measure, the 'Topes tacked on one more run in the fourth on an RBI single by Fields that made the score 6-1, but it wasn't necessary thanks to the exploits of Antonini, who earned his first win of the 2012 season. The left-hander tossed 5.2 innings, allowing one run on four hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven. As great as the starter was, he was picked up by more excellent work from the Isotopes' bullpen, as Brent Leach, Cole St. Clair, and Ramon Troncoso combined for 3.1 innings of scoreless ball to salt away the 6-1 victory.

DUAL THREAT: Right-hander Stephen Fife makes the start coming off a game in which he was a factor both on the mound and at the plate. On April 17 vs. Iowa, Fife pitched 5.2 innings, allowing six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 triumph over the I-Cubs. Even more notable than his pitching exploits, however, was Fife's performance with a bat, with which he collected two hits, including a two-run double, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009. Despite entering the season with a career total of eight at-bats (no hits) which he picked up in the second half of last season with Chattanooga, Fife is a 3-for-4 on the season with just one strikeout.

FIVE ALIVE: The Isotopes are officially the hottest team in the Pacific Coast League, thanks to their current five-game winning streak, which is the longest current winning streak in the PCL. Not only does Albuquerque have its longest winning streak since winning six in a row from July 16-21, 2010, the 'Topes are tied with four other teams (Oklahoma City, New Orleans, Colorado Springs, and Sacramento) for the second longest winning streak in the PCL this season behind Omaha, which won six in a row (including two against the Isotopes) from April 7-12.

STRONG STARTS: While there are a lot of reasons for the Isotopes' current five-game winning streak, one of the biggest may be the team's starting pitching, which has been fantastic. In the last five games, 'Topes starting pitchers are 4-0 with a 4.82 ERA (15 ER / 28.0 IP). They've been particularly lights-out over the last three games, going a perfect 3-0 with a 2.75 ERA (6 ER / 19.2 IP) while striking out 18 and walking just four.

CASTY CAN'T BE STOPPED: While Alex Castellanos has enjoyed a spectacular Triple-A debut, batting .354 (23x65), he's been even more spectacular on the road. Castellanos has gotten a hit in eight of nine games played away from Isotopes Park while compiling a .429 (15x35) batting average with five doubles, two triples, two homers, and four RBI. Last night's two homer performance extended his current road hitting streak to six games, a stretch in which he's batted .522 (12x23).

FIRST BLOOD: This season the Isotopes are 5-1 when scoring first in a contest. Conversely, the 'Topes have a record of 4-7 when the opposition gets on the scoreboard first.

TODAY'S START: Righty Stephen Fife takes the mound coming off his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009. Suffered the loss in his first career Triple-A start on April 7 when he lasted just 1.1 innings, giving up five runs, only one of which was earned, on six hits while walking two and striking out three in a 5-0 'Topes loss to the Omaha Storm Chasers. Fife was tagged for five runs in the first inning, all them with two outs and all of them unearned after a throwing error by second baseman Alex Castellanos.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with Double-A Chattanooga and Double-A Portland... set new career-bests in wins, innings pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for second-most in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Birmingham... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2010, his first season with Double-A Portland, he paced the club in wins (8), starts (26), and innings (136.1) while finishing third on the team with 82 strikeouts... named to the Eastern League's midseason All-Star Team after going 5-2 with a 3.83 ERA before the break... selected as the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for August 30-Sept. 6 after going 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) and seven strikeouts in two starts... limited left-handed opposition to a .248 batting average... went 3-1 with a 3.05 ERA (22 ER/65.0 IP) in 12 road starts.

In 2009, combined to go 3-5 with a 3.71 ERA (36 ER / 87.1 IP) in 18 starts with Single-A Greenville and Single-A Salem... began the season with Greenville where despite going winless in eight starts, he posted a 2.70 ERA (11 ER / 36.2 IP) with 35 strikeouts and just four walks... finished the year tops amongst Boston's farm system (min. 30.0 IP) with a combined 6.14 strikeout-to-walk ratio (86 K / 14 BB)... allowed just one home run in 36.0 innings pitched with the Drive... went 1-0 with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER / 17.2 IP) in three July starts after his promotion to Salem.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
