'TOPES EDGE REDHAWKS FOR LUCKY NUMBER SEVEN: The Albuquerque Isotopes got some stellar pitching and a clutch two-run homer by Elian Herrera to edge the Oklahoma City RedHawks 3-2 in a crisply played contest Monday night at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Albuquerque grabbed a quick lead in the second when Jeff Baisley legged out a triple to right and immediately scored on a double by Tim Federowicz to give the 'Topes a quick 1-0 edge, but the RedHawks responded in the bottom of the frame. Brett Wallace tied the contest with one swing of his bat, a towering solo homer to left, before Jimmy Paredes beat out an infield single by just eluding the tag of pitcher Will Savage. Landon Powell then roped a two-out double to right, scoring Paredes all the way from first and putting the 'Hawks ahead 2-1. Even though he was pressed into his first spot-start of the season, Savage was superb, working six strong innings in which he allowed just the two runs on five hits while walking one and striking out two en route to his fourth straight victory. The excellent pitching set up Herrera, whose turn it was to play hero in the seventh. After Federowicz led off the inning with a single, Herrera crushed a two-out, two-run homer over the wall in left to suddenly give the 'Topes a 3-2 edge. Albuquerque's bullpen would make sure the one-run lead was safe as lefty Derrick Loop who had just joined the Isotopes about an hour before first pitch, authored two scoreless innings before Scott Rice finished off the 'Hawks with a scoreless ninth to secure the victory.

ELY ON TO KEEP IT GOING: John Ely takes the mound looking to not only continue Albuquerque's current winning streak, but also extend his own streak of quality starts. On April 14, Ely allowed Omaha just one run on four hits in six innings in a no-decision before following that performance up with seven strong innings in which he allowed Iowa just three runs on six hits to earn his first victory of 2012. Combined, the right-hander is 1-0 with a 2.76 ERA (4 ER / 13.0 IP) over his last two appearances, and has walked just two over that span while striking out eight.

SEVEN UP: With last night's dramatic comeback win, the Isotopes extended their amazing winning streak to seven games, the longest by any team in the PCL so far this season and tied for the third longest in 'Topes team history. The Isotopes' longest winning streak is nine games set from April 18-27, 2006 and the team has rattled off eight-game streaks on three occasions, the last one coming on April 14-21, 2008. The longest winning streak in Albuquerque Triple-A baseball history is 13, set by the Dukes from June 22-July 8, 1981. The Isotopes have also won back-to-back series for the first time since June 4-12 of last season.

SPEEDING UP THE STANDINGS: By virtue of the aforementioned winning streak, the Isotopes have been speeding up the standings like a freight train. As of exactly one week ago, the 'Topes found themselves five games back in the division, but now they have climbed to within just a game and a half of division-leading New Orleans and one game of second-place Oklahoma City.

WELCOME BACK BECKS!: It took just four days, but Joe Becker finds himself back in an Isotopes uniform. Unfortunately, the circumstances for Becker's return are not good for the 'Topes, as red-hot infielder Alex Castellanos has been placed on the Disabled List after straining his left hamstring while running out a ground out in a pinch-hit appearance last night. Meanwhile, Becker, who was transferred to Single-A Rancho Cucamonga on April 20, appeared in four games for the Quakes, batting .313 (5x16) with two runs scored.

NEXT HOMESTAND RIGHT AROUND THE CORNER!: As great as the first homestand was both on and off the field, it'll be tough to top, but the second homestand of the 2012 season will definitely give it a run for its money. The Isotopes are back home next Monday for the first of three 50-Cent Hot Dog Nights. Then, on Friday, May 4 and Saturday, May 5, the 'Topes will have back-to-back fireworks shows (the first two of the season) and back-to-back pre-game Little League Banner Parades!

TODAY'S START: John Ely takes the mound coming off his first victory of 2012, a stellar start on April 19 vs. Iowa when he allowed three runs on six hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 'Topes win. Also enjoyed a brilliant outing on April 14 vs. Omaha when he wound up with a tough-luck no-decision. Ely worked 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out three. He left the game with a 7-1 lead and in line to get the win, but the Storm Chasers scored six in the top of the seventh en route to a 14-10 win in 13 innings.

2011: Played most of the season in Albuquerque, going 7-8 with a 5.99 ERA (96 ER / 144.1 IP) in 25 starts, tied for the most on the team with Dana Eveland... was a perfect 3-0 with a 4.06 ERA (14 ER / 31.0 IP) in five starts in the month of July... recalled on April 10 and made a spot start for the Dodgers that day at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres... optioned back to Albuquerque on April 11... nearly threw his first career no-hitter and the first no-hitter in Isotopes history in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20... after holding the I-Cubs hitless going into the seventh and final inning, he struck out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith... then retired the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career... named PCL Pitcher of the Week for April 18-25 thanks to his performance... had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career... allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in the 3-1 'Topes victory... recalled on June 4 and had a brief stay with the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing of his career - 2007 at Rookie-Level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati... entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win... if he had worked the ninth, he would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA... optioned back to Albuquerque on June 6... had a short stay with the Dodgers after being recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games before being optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7... recalled one last time on Sept. 6 and made three more relief appearances for Dodgers, not allowing a run in 4.0 innings... in five total appearances in LA (one start) went 0-1 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut in 2010, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6-June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17-July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from Sept. 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodgers rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins.
