ISOTOPES EDGE ZEPHYRS 4-3 IN 12 INNINGS: Luis Cruz roped an RBI double in the top of the 12th to send the Albuquerque Isotopes to a dramatic 4-3, 12-inning win over the New Orleans Zephyrs Saturday night at Zephyr Field. Knotted 3-3 in the top of the 12th, pinch-hitter Josh Fields led off the frame by drawing a walk from Z's reliever Elih Villanueva. After coaxing a fly-out and a ground-out, Villanueva looked poised to get out of the inning, until Cruz took a 3-2 pitch and laced it into the corner in left field for a double, scoring Fields all the way from first and giving Albuquerque a 4-3 edge. The 'Topes then placed the game in the extremely capable hands of their right-handed closer Josh Wall, who delivered a one-two-three bottom of the 12th to secure his fifth save of the season and the 4-3 Isotopes win.

MARCHING FIFE: Right-hander Stephen Fife makes the start seven days removed from his last outing on April 22 at Oklahoma City when he tied a team record in walks. In 4.2 innings, Fife issued eight free passes, tying the franchise mark set by knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha batters in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. What is odd is that prior to that eight walk outburst, Fife had been stingy with the bases on balls, walking just five in 11.2 innings over his first three starts of the season. The walks also didn't end up hurting Fife that badly, as the right-hander allowed just five runs on the eight walks and seven hits and left the contest with a 6-5 lead in a game eventually won by the 'Topes 11-10 in 14 innings. Fife's 13 walks on the year is tied for fourth-most by a pitcher in the PCL.

WELCOME BACK, MATT!: Fresh off 10 days in which he was recovering from a strained left hamstring, Matt Angle celebrated his return to the active roster with two hits in five at-bats in last night's extra-inning win. The performance was Angle's first two-hit game of the season. Even before the injury-induced hiatus, Angle was starting to heat up and now he has collected hits in each of his last three games, going 4-for-12 (.333) over that stretch.

EXTRA CREDIT: Last night's 12-inning affair was the Isotopes' second extra-inning contest in six games and third of the season, tied with three other teams for second-most in the PCL. Nashville and New Orleans have played the most free baseball in the league this season, with four games apiece (both are 2-2). Albuquerque is 2-1 so far this season in extra stanzas.

HERRERA STILL HOT: Elian Herrera continues to be one of the Isotopes' hottest hitters, racking up his eighth multi-hit game with a pair of hits last night, tying for third on the 'Topes in multi-hit games with Luis Cruz behind Scott Van Slyke (10) and Alex Castellanos (9). In each of the 14 games Herrera has started, he's gotten a hit, amassing a .338 (23x68) batting average this season. In addition to his contributions at the plate, Herrera has also been a valuable asset in the field as well, seeing time five different positions (2B, 3B, SS, CF, DH) this season.

ROSER RE-WRITES: After skating through the first 15 days of the season with just four roster moves, the Isotopes have had 14 separate roster transactions over the last nine days, including the team's first big league call-up and subsequent return, as well as four different DL moves.

LET THE SUN SHINE IN: The Isotopes have won two of their last three day games, improving their record in the sunshine to 3-3 this year. Albuquerque is also 2-2 in day games played on the road, with their last day game being their 11-10, 14-inning marathon (which Stephen Fife also started) on April 22 at Oklahoma City.

NEXT HOMESTAND STARTS TOMORROW!! As great as the first homestand was both on and off the field, it'll be tough to top, but the second homestand of the 2012 season will definitely give it a run for its money. The Isotopes are back home tomorrow for the first of three 50-Cent Hot Dog Nights. Then, on Friday, May 4 and Saturday, May 5, the 'Topes will have back-to-back fireworks shows (the first two of the season) and back-to-back pre-game Little League Banner Parades!

TODAY'S START: Stephen Fife makes the start coming off an outing at Oklahoma City on April 22 when he tied a franchise record by walking eight batters in just 4.2 innings while allowing five runs on seven hits in an eventual 11-10 'Topes win 14 innings. The eight walks ties knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha Royals in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. Enjoyed his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009. Suffered the loss in his first career Triple-A start on April 7 when he lasted just 1.1 innings, giving up five runs, only one of which was earned, on six hits while walking two and striking out three in a 5-0 'Topes loss to the Omaha Storm Chasers. Fife was tagged for five runs in the first inning, all them with two outs and all of them unearned after a throwing error by second baseman Alex Castellanos.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with Double-A Chattanooga and Double-A Portland... set new career-bests in wins, innings pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for second-most in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Binghamton... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2010, his first season with Double-A Portland, he paced the club in wins (8), starts (26), and innings (136.1) while finishing third on the team with 82 strikeouts... named to the Eastern League's midseason All-Star Team after going 5-2 with a 3.83 ERA before the break... selected as the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for August 30-Sept. 6 after going 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) and seven strikeouts in two starts... limited left-handed opposition to a .248 batting average... went 3-1 with a 3.05 ERA (22 ER/65.0 IP) in 12 road starts.

In 2009, combined to go 3-5 with a 3.71 ERA (36 ER / 87.1 IP) in 18 starts with Single-A Greenville and Single-A Salem... began the season with Greenville where despite going winless in eight starts, he posted a 2.70 ERA (11 ER / 36.2 IP) with 35 strikeouts and just four walks... finished the year tops amongst Boston's farm system (min. 30.0 IP) with a combined 6.14 strikeout-to-walk ratio (86 K / 14 BB)... allowed just one home run in 36.0 innings pitched with the Drive... went 1-0 with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER / 17.2 IP) in three July starts after his promotion to Salem.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
