OKLAHOMA CITY REDHAWKS (28-20) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (27-22)

ISOTOPES ROUTED BY REDHAWKS, 10-4: The Albuquerque Isotopes were victims of a five-run fifth, falling to the Oklahoma City RedHawks 10-4 Friday night at Isotopes Park. The RedHawks jumped to an early 1-0 lead in the second off a solo shot to left from Brad Snyder, but Jeff Baisley quickly matched the homer, blasting a dinger of his own to right-center to tie the game 1-1. Oklahoma City responded in the third with two runs to grab a 3-1 edge before the 'Topes battled back in the bottom of the frame when Trent Oeltjen crushed a solo homer to left, cutting the deficit to 3-2. OKC put the game out of reach with a five-run fifth that began with a bunt single from Jimmy Paredes, who promptly scored on an RBI double from Fernando Martinez. Brett Wallace was then plunked by a pitch from Albuquerque pitcher Stephen Fife and Angel Sanchez roped an RBI single, plating Martinez and putting runners on the corners with two outs. Reliever Scott Rice then came on for Fife and immediately yielded a three-run homer from Landon Powell that capped off the inning and gave the 'Hawks an 8-2 lead. Albuquerque refused to quit, largely due to Luis Cruz, who belted an RBI single in the fifth and a solo homer in the eighth, bringing the Isotopes to within 8-4. The RedHawks tacked on two more in the ninth as Snyder lifted a two-run shot, his second of the night, that finished off the 10-4 RedHawks win.

ELY TO THE RESCUE: With the Isotopes looking to stop a losing streak, they turn to their hottest pitcher in John Ely, who continues to dominate at Isotopes Park. In his last start, the right-hander authored eight scoreless innings, allowing just four hits and a walk while striking out six. Despite leaving with a 2-0 lead, however, Ely watched from the dugout as the Fresno Grizzlies rallied for two in the top of the ninth before Albuquerque inevitably scored a run in the bottom of the frame to take a 3-2 victory. In five starts at The Lab, Ely is a perfect 2-0 with an astonishing 1.60 ERA (6 ER / 33.2 IP) and has walked just six while striking out 28. At home, opposing hitters are batting just .242 (30x124) against him. By contrast, last year the right-hander was 3-4 with a 7.34 ERA (56 / 68.2 IP) in 12 starts at Isotopes Park.

IN A FUNK: For the first time all season, the Isotopes have dropped three straight games at home, part of a tough stretch in which the 'Topes have lost eight of their last 11. As a result, Albuquerque has fallen from 3.5 games up in the PCL's American Southern Division on May 13 to trailing by a game and a half, the 'Topes' largest deficit since they were two games behind on May 4. In the last three games, the Isotopes have also been uncharacteristic victims of blow-outs, having been outscored 31-16 in the last three contests.

CROOKED NUMBERS: In each of the last four games, the Isotopes have fallen prey to big innings, with the opposition posting frames of five runs or more. On May 22, Fresno scored six in the sixth, but after that the damage has been contained to the fifth, with the Grizzlies scoring five in the frame on May 23, six on May 24 and Oklahoma City five last night. Prior to Tuesday, the 'Topes had given up five runs or more in an inning just seven times through the first 45 games.

CASTELLANOS RETURNS!: Albuquerque's lineup will be bolstered by the addition of infielder Alex Castellanos, who is back with the 'Topes today after spending over a month on the Disabled List rehabbing a strained left hamstring. Before his injury, which occurred when he was trying to leg out an infield single in a pinch-hit appearance on April 23 at Oklahoma City, Castellanos was on fire, batting .366 (26x71) with seven doubles, four triples, four homers, and 11 RBI in 18 games. To make room for Castellanos on the roster, outfielder Kyle Russell was transferred back to Double-A Chattanooga after batting .111 (2x18) in seven games with the Isotopes.

KEMP, RIVERA TO REHAB WITH 'TOPES: As the perfect cap to what has been a spectacular homestand, Dodgers superstar Matt Kemp and outfielder Juan Rivera will each be making rehab appearances in Albuquerque for two games beginning tomorrow. Both players are working their way back to the Dodgers from left hamstring strains that landed them on the DL on May 14 and May 9, respectively.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander John Ely makes the start coming off a very tough no-decision on May 21 vs. Fresno when he pitched 8.0 scoreless innings allowing just four hits while walking one and striking out six. Ely left the game with a 2-0 lead, but the Grizzlies tied the contest 2-2 in the top of the ninth before the 'Topes rallied for a 3-2 win in the bottom of the frame. Had a dominant 3-2 win at Tacoma on May 10 when he allowed just two runs on four hits while walking three and striking out a career-high 11, shattering his old career-high of nine set in 2008 when he was at Single-A Winston-Salem in the South Atlantic League. Authored 15.0 scoreless innings in three straight home starts from April 19-May 5. Earned his first victory of 2012, a stellar start on April 19 vs. Iowa when he allowed three runs on six hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 'Topes win. Also had a brilliant outing on April 14 vs. Omaha when he wound up with a tough-luck no-decision. Ely worked 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out three. He left the game with a 7-1 lead and in line to get the win, but the Storm Chasers scored six in the top of the seventh en route to a 14-10 win in 13 innings.

2011: Played most of the season in Albuquerque, going 7-8 with a 5.99 ERA (96 ER / 144.1 IP) in 25 starts.. recalled on April 10 and made a spot start for the Dodgers that day at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres... optioned back to Albuquerque on April 11... nearly threw his first career no-hitter and the first no-hitter in Isotopes history in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20... after holding the I-Cubs hitless going into the seventh and final inning, he struck out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith... then retired the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career... named PCL Pitcher of the Week for April 18-25 thanks to his performance... had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career... allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in the 3-1 'Topes victory... recalled on June 4 and had a brief stay with the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing of his career - 2007 at Rookie-Level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati... entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win... if he had worked the ninth, he would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for L.A... optioned back to Albuquerque on June 6... had a short stay with the Dodgers after being recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games before being optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7... recalled one last time on Sept. 6 and made three more relief appearances for Dodgers, not allowing a run in 4.0 innings... in five total appearances in LA (one start) went 0-1 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut in 2010, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6-June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17-July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from Sept. 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodgers rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins.
