## OKLAHOMA CITY REDHAWKS (28-21) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (28-22)

**‘TOPES DOUBLE DOWN ‘HAWKS, 7-4:** The Albuquerque Isotopes set a franchise-record with nine doubles as they captured a 7-4 victory against the Oklahoma City RedHawks on Saturday night at Isotopes Park. After each team scored a run in the first and Oklahoma City added a tally in the fourth, Albuquerque claimed its first lead of the night in the bottom of the frame on RBI doubles from Brian Cavazos-Galvez and Trent Oeltjen to give the ‘Topes a 3-2 lead. The RedHawks knotted the game at 3-3 with a run in the top of the fifth before the ‘Topes took the lead for good in the bottom of the frame, as Jeff Baisley blasted a solo home run to left to give the home team a 4-3 edge. Albuquerque poured on three more runs in the sixth beginning with a pinch-hit sacrifice fly by Josh Fields and continuing with an RBI single from Oeltjen and a run-scoring double by Alex Castellanos to stake Albuquerque to a 7-3 advantage. Oklahoma City inched closer with a run in the seventh but Albuquerque closer Josh Wall slammed the door, retiring the side in the ninth to close out a 7-4 ‘Topes win.

**LEFTY LOOKING FOR A WIN:** Lefty Michael Antonini makes the start looking for his first victory since April 21, when he recorded his only win so far this season with a triumph at Oklahoma City on April 21. That’s not to say the south-paw hasn’t pitched well, which has hardly been the case. In his last start on May 22 against Fresno, Antonini authored three perfect frames and five scoreless frames before finally yielding three runs in the sixth and ending up with a no-decision in an eventual 8-7 ‘Topes win. Taking out a tough outing on May 17 vs. Sacramento, Antonini has allowed just six runs over a 17.0 IP stretch (3.18 ERA).

**SEEING DOUBLE:** Just four days after tying the franchise record for most doubles in a game the Isotopes broke it, pounding out nine two-baggers last night to set a new mark. Over the course of the last five games, the ‘Topes have hit 23 doubles and have 36 so far on the homestand, bringing their total on the season to 126, tops in the PCL by 13 (Las Vegas is in second with 113 doubles on the year).

**KEMP, RIVERA TO REHAB WITH ‘TOPES:** As the perfect cap to what has been a spectacular homestand, Dodgers superstar Matt Kemp and outfielder Juan Rivera will each be making rehab appearances in Albuquerque for two games beginning tonight. Both players are working their way back to the Dodgers from left hamstring strains that landed them on the DL on May 14 and May 9, respectively. Before getting hurt, Kemp was enjoying a monster season, batting .359 (42x117) with five doubles, a triple, 12 homers, and 28 RBI. Rivera was also having a solid campaign before his injury, batting .247 (20x81) with three doubles, two homers, and 13 RBI. Tonight Kemp is scheduled to start in center and Rivera in left and both players are expected to play about 5.0 innings. With the pair of outfielders, the Isotopes have now had five Dodgers come to Albuquerque to rehab this year (RHP- Ronald Belisario, IF- Ivan De Jesus Jr., and IF- Jerry Hairston, Jr).

**DOUBLE-DIGITS:** Both Josh Fields and Luis Cruz are working on double-digit hitting streaks with Fields collecting a hit in 11 straight games and Cruz 10 straight. Since his streak began on May 12, Fields is batting .304 (14x46) with seven runs, four doubles, a homer, and three RBI while Cruz has been even hotter, going 17-for-43 (.395) with 11 runs, seven doubles, a homer, and eight RBI since beginning his streak on May 17, the first day of the current homestand.

**JERSEY AUCTION:** Like last night, the ‘Topes will be wearing camo jerseys, which will be auctioned off after tonight’s game. Proceeds from the auction will go to the New Mexico chapter of Disabled American Veterans and Wounded Warriors. In addition to jerseys from everyone on the team, including rehabbers Matt Kemp and Juan Rivera, a jersey worn by actor Bryan Cranston in last weekend’s Celebrity Softball Game will also be auctioned.

**WOODY BOBBLE!** Tomorrow, the Isotopes will be giving away bobbleheads of ‘Topes legend and Albuquerque Baseball Hall of Famer Jason Wood. The first 3,000 fans will get the bobblehead courtesy of Sandia Resort & Casino.

**TODAY'S START:** Michael Antonini takes the mound coming off a no-decision on May 22 when he allowed the Fresno Grizzlies three runs on just three hits and four walks in 5.0 innings in an 8-7 win. Enjoyed his best outing of the year, a 4-0 hard-luck loss at Tacoma, on May 11. The lefty allowed just one run on three hits in 6.0 innings while fanning a season-high eight, but wound up taking the defeat after the 'Topes were no-hit into the seventh in the shutout loss. Had a 10-day period that saw him win his first game of the season and get his first Major League call-up but not pitch. After beating Oklahoma City on April 21, Antonini was recalled by the Dodgers on April 24 but did not see game action before being optioned back to Albuquerque on April 28. Had an unusual relief appearance at Iowa on April 11 when he was scheduled to make the start that day against the I-Cubs, but was held back while the Dodgers determined if there was a need to bring him up. In the fourth inning it was determined that Antonini could in fact pitch for the Isotopes and he immediately went into the game in relief of Francisco Felix, tossing five innings in which he allowed a run on four hits and two walks while striking out four in a 5-1 'Topes loss.

**2011:** Set a professional career high with 10 wins (10-9) and tied a career-best mark for the second consecutive season with 131 strikeouts while pitching the entire season at Double-A Chattanooga... led all Lookouts pitchers with 27 starts and 148.0 innings pitched... ranked third in Dodger system in strikeouts... was selected as a Southern League Midseason All-Star and was credited with a hold in the All-Star Game on June 21, pitching 0.2 innings, striking out a batter and allowing no baserunners for North All-Stars in a 6-3 win... named as the July winner of Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga after going 4-0 with a 2.08 ERA (8 ER / 34.2 IP) in six starts... selected as the left-handed pitcher on MiLB.com's Dodger Organization All-Star team... following the season, pitched for Indios de Mayaguez in the Puerto Rican Winter League.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Split 2010 season between Double-A Birmingham and Triple-A Buffalo, combining to set career highs with 29 starts, 168.0 innings, and 131 strikeouts... started the season at Binghamton, going 6-9 with a 4.32 ERA (63 ER / 131.1 IP) in 23 appearances, all starts... led the B-Mets in strikeouts (106), innings-pitched (131.1) and starts (23)... fanned 106 while walking just 26... got a complete-game win on June 10 in the first game of a doubleheader vs. Bowie, allowing one run on four hits in seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 3-1 Binghamton win... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on August 9 and finished the season with the Bisons, going 2-3 with a 5.11 ERA (21 ER / 37.0 IP) in six starts... struck out 25 while walking five... traded to the Dodgers in exchange for infielder Chin-lung Hu on December 27.

Spent time in 2009 with Binghamton and Buffalo... spent most of the season at Double-A, going 7-5 with a 5.32 ERA (68 ER / 115.0 IP) in 25 games (20 starts)... set a career high and tied for the Binghamton club lead with seven victories... promoted to Buffalo on May 15 and made his Triple-A debut that night in a start vs. Gwinnett... made one more start for the Bisons on May 21 before returning to Binghamton on May 22 and finishing the season at Double-A... was 0-1 with a 12.27 ERA (10 ER / 7.1 IP) in his two Triple-A starts.

Saw action at three levels of the Mets organization in 2008, going a combined 9-7 with a 2.77 ERA (50 ER / 162.2 IP) while holding opponents to a .228 batting average with Single-A Savannah, Single-A St. Lucie, and Double-A Binghamton... fanned a total of 126 while walking 39 between all three stops... tossed the first complete game of his career on July 19 in the first game of a doubleheader at Lakeland, allowing one hit (a solo home run) and striking out seven in seven innings of work...

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Michael John Antonini... All-American for Georgia College in 2006... went 18-7 with a 3.42 ERA in two seasons for Bobcats, striking out 153 batters in 192 innings... pitched for 2005 National Junior College Athletic Association national championship Gloucester County College (NJ) team... originally selected by Philadelphia in the 41st round of the 2006 draft, but did not sign.
