OKLAHOMA CITY REDHAWKS (28-22) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (29-22)

KEMP, RIVERA POWER 'TOPES TO 11-9 WIN: Los Angeles Dodgers rehabbing outfielders Matt Kemp and Juan Rivera went a combined 3-for-5 with two home runs and five RBI as the Albuquerque Isotopes hung on for an 11-9 win over the Oklahoma City RedHawks Sunday night at Isotopes Park. With a runner on second and one out in the first inning, Kemp, who has been on the DL since May 14 with a strained left hamstring, showed no signs of rust, ripping an RBI single to left that gave Albuquerque an early 1-0 edge. Rivera, who's been on the shelf since May 9 also with a strained left hamstring, then crushed a two-run homer, extending the lead 3-0. The RedHawks answered with a run of their own in the second, cutting the deficit 3-1, but Kemp padded the 'Topes lead in the bottom of the frame. With one on and two down, Kemp sent the first pitch he saw over the fence in right to extend the 'Topes lead, 5-1. The Isotopes then strung together a five-run sixth to add some breathing room. Josh Bard started the action with a solo homer to right field, widening the 'Topes advantage 6-1. After an RBI single by Brian Cavazos-Galvez, Jeff Baisley capped off the Isotopes sixth with a three-run home run to boost Albuquerque's lead to 10-1. The 'Topes tacked on one more run in the eighth to make it 11-1 and in the end, the home team would need the large advantage as OKC added four runs in the eighth and four more in the ninth, narrowing the deficit to 11-9. With the tying run at the plate in the ninth, Scott Rice stopped the bleeding by punching out Brandon Barnes to seal an 11-9 Isotopes victory.

PARISI POWER: Right-hander Mike Parisi takes the mound still working his way back from missing almost two weeks with a right shoulder impingement. In his first start back after being reinstated off the DL, Parisi was limited to 60 pitches and turned in a solid outing on May 23 vs. Fresno, tossing 4.0 innings in which he allowed just one run on four hits and a walk while striking out three. Even with the truncated appearance, the right-hander continues to have the PCL's lowest earned run average with a mark of just 2.57 (12 ER / 42.0 IP). Five of Parisi's eight starts this year have come at Isotopes Park, where he's been superb, going 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (6 ER / 25.0 IP). Not surprisingly, part of Parisi's success can be attributed to limiting the number of bases on balls he's surrendered. In 42.0 total innings of work this year, the right-hander has issued just 11 walks while striking out 35 and has allowed 49 total baserunners, which comes out to 10.5 runners every 9.0 innings, the third-lowest ratio in the PCL.

JOLTIN' JEFF: Infielder Jeff Baisley has tied a team-high by homering in three straight contests, equaling the same feat accomplished by Scott Van Slyke from May 3-5. In addition to his power stroke, Baisley has collected hits in nine of his last 10 games, a span in which he's batting a blistering .410 (16x39) with nine runs, three doubles, a triple, four homers, and 11 RBI. Baisley also has 11 RBI in 10 games this season with Oklahoma City, which leads the team.

BACK ON TOP: In what is looking more and more like a see-saw battle all year long, the Isotopes have reclaimed first place in the PCL's American Southern Division by virtue of two straight wins against the RedHawks. After today, the 'Topes will face the 'Hawks just one more time, a four-game set in Oklahoma City from August 27-30 that will be Albuquerque's last road series of the year. With a mark of 8-3 against OKC, a win today would guarantee Albuquerque a winning record against its division nemesis.

AWESOME AUSSIE: Since being inserted into the lead-off spot in the Isotopes batting order, Trent Oeltjen has caught fire, batting .345 (10x29) with four doubles, two homers, and four RBI in seven games batting out of the top spot. Oeltjen has racked up multiple hits in each of his last three contests, going 7-for-15 and raising his average on the season from .237 to .260 in just three days.

WOODY BOBBLE!: Today the Isotopes will be giving away bobbleheads of 'Topes legend and Albuquerque Baseball Hall of Famer Jason Wood. The first 3,000 fans will get the bobblehead courtesy of Sandia Resort & Casino.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Mike Parisi makes the start after a 60-pitch effort on May 23 vs. Fresno, his first start after missing 13 games while recovering from a right shoulder impingement. In that outing, Parisi allowed one run on four hits in 4.0 innings while walking one and striking out three in an eventual 10-7 'Topes loss. Suffered his injury in a start on May 7 vs. Nashville. After pitching 2.0 innings against the Sounds, Parisi was forced to depart the game after allowing two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out one in a game eventually won by the 'Topes 8-3. Was placed on the DL on May 9 (retroactive to May 8). Had a tough-luck no-decision on May 2 vs. Oklahoma City when he tossed 7.0 shutout innings in which he allowed just four hits while walking two and striking out seven. Left with a 1-0 lead and was in line to get the win until the RedHawks rallied for four runs in the ninth to win 4-1. Had a hard luck loss at New Orleans on April 27 when he allowed just one run on four hits in 7.0 innings while walking one and striking out a season-high seven and still wound up on the short end of a 2-1 'Topes defeat. Enjoyed his first victory on April 20 vs. Iowa when we superb, firing 7.0 innings in which he allowed just two runs on three hits while walking one and fanning six in a 5-4 'Topes victory. After five strong innings on the season's Opening Day in Omaha on April 5, the right-hander tossed another five solid frames on April 10 at Iowa, giving up three runs on five hits while walking two and striking out six. Parisi left with a 4-3 lead only to watch as the game became tied at 5-5 in the eighth before Josh Fields won it with a pinch-hit solo homer in the top of the ninth.

2011: Started the season with the Long Island Ducks in the independent Atlantic League before signing as a free agent and joining Albuquerque on July 20... went 6-4 with a 3.50 ERA (31 ER / 79.2 IP) in 13 games (all starts) with the Ducks... authored a shutout on June 15 at Lancaster when allowed just four hits over nine scoreless innings while walking two and striking out nine in a 6-0 Long Island win... selected to the Atlantic League All-Star team and pitched a perfect second inning in the Atlantic League All-Star Game on July 13 at York, PA... struck out a season-high 10 in seven innings in a 3-1 win vs. Southern Maryland on May 11, while allowing one run on four hits and two walks... earned a victory in his Isotopes debut on July 23 vs. New Orleans... won five straight decisions over six starts from August 3-30, in which he posted a 4.23 ERA (18 ER / 38.1 IP)... his five victories tied three other pitchers for the most wins in the league over the month of August... held opponents to three earned runs or less in each of his last five outings... yielded just eight hits in 46 at-bats against the leadoff hitter (.174) and held opposing hitters to a .148 (8x54) average with runners in scoring position... fanned a season-high eight over 6.2 innings in a no-decision vs. Memphis on August 20... pitched for Margarita in the Venezuelan Winter League, going 1-3 with a 2.09 ERA (12 ER / 51.2 IP) in nine games (eight starts)... went to Spring Training with Chicago (NL) but was released on March 23.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Started the 2010 season at Triple-A Iowa after being selected by the Cubs from St. Louis in the Major League portion of the Rule 5 Draft on December 10, 2009... went 0-3 with a 8.50 ERA (17 ER / 18.0 IP) in five starts for the I-Cubs before being transferred to Double-A Tennessee on May 5... appeared in one game for the Smokies on May 10, allowing one run on three hits in 2.2 innings... diagnosed with bone chips in his right shoulder and had season-ending surgery at the end of May.

Limited to just five outings in 2009 while recovering from Tommy John surgery... went 0-2 with 4.70 ERA (8 ER / 15.1 IP) in stops between the Gulf Coast League Cardinals and the Single-A Palm Beach Cardinals... posted a 1.17 ERA (1 ER / 7.2 IP) with a 0-1 record, nine strikeouts and a 0.83 average against (2x24) in three starts with the GCL Cardinals... joined Palm Beach on August 28, going 0-1 with an 8.22 ERA (7 ER / 7.2 IP) in two starts... played for the Surprise Rafters of the Arizona Fall League, going 3-2 with a 4.44 ERA (13 ER / 26.1 IP) with 15 strikeouts.

Made his Major League debut in two stints with the St. Louis Cardinals in 2008, posting an 0-4 record and a 8.22 ERA (21 ER / 23.0 IP) in 12 total appearances (two starts)... made his Major League debut on May 5 at Colorado, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings... had season-ending Tommy John surgery on August 20.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Michael Richard Parisi... attended Manhattan College in New York and pitched for the Jaspers from 2002-2004... went to Sachem High School in Lake Ronkonkoma, New York... he and his wife Leah were married last fall.
