KEMP LIFTS 'TOPES TO 11-9 SERIES-ENDING WIN: Dodgers superstar Matt Kemp, in his second and final rehab game with the Albuquerque Isotopes, went 3-for-4 with a home run and a double as the 'Topes downed the Oklahoma City RedHawks 11-9 on Monday afternoon at Isotopes Park. After OKC jumped to a 1-0 lead in the top of the first, the 'Topes responded in their half of the inning when Matt Angle drew a leadoff walk and stole second base. Josh Fields then ripped a single to left, plating Angle and evening the score 1-1. Kemp then destroyed an 0-1 pitch over the left field wall, giving the 'Topes a 3-1 lead. The 'Hawks would add one run in the third before Albuquerque scored four runs in the bottom half, beginning with a double to right-center from Kemp. Following a walk to fellow MLB rehabber Juan Rivera, Jeff Baisley roped a double down the left-field line, scoring Kemp and extending the lead to 4-2. Oklahoma City starter Aneurly Rodriguez intentionally walked Tim Federowicz to load the bases, but the strategy backfired as the hurler walked 'Topes relief pitcher Derrick Loop, bringing in Rivera and making the score 5-2. Angle then capped off the inning with a two-run single to right, extending Albuquerque's advantage 7-2. OKC drew within two in the fourth, but Rivera added to the Isotopes lead with an RBI single, plating Fields and extending the home team's advantage to 8-5. The Isotopes built a cushion in the eighth with a walk to Angle and an intentional walk to Trent Oeljten, setting up Brian Cavazos-Galvez, blasted a three-run homer to left, making the score 11-6, 'Topes. The five-run lead proved vital as the 'Hawks rallied for three runs in the ninth before 'Topes closer Josh Wall was able to coax a two-out flyout with the tying run at the plate, preserving an 11-9 Isotopes win.

TIME TO START A NEW STREAK: Right-hander Will Savage makes the start coming off his first loss of the season, a defeat on May 24 vs. Fresno at Isotopes Park that snapped a seven-game winning streak. In that outing, Savage allowed a season-high seven runs on four hits in just 4.0 innings, his shortest appearance in seven starts. What really ended up undermining the right-hander was four walks, which was not only a season-high, but half of the total number of free passes he'd allowed in six starts previous to that one combined. As it stands, Savage has tied a franchise record with seven consecutive wins and remains in second in the PCL in victories behind Fresno's Eric Hacker, who defeated Savage in his last outing to earn his eighth win.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: After a season-high 12 straight games at home, the Isotopes find themselves back on the road where they've been faring well of late. Albuquerque has won seven of its last 10 games played away from Isotopes Park.

BACK IN THE BIG EASY: Albuquerque today begins an eight-game road trip with a four-game series in New Orleans against the Zephyrs, the 'Topes' second and final visit to the Crescent City this season. Last month, the Isotopes split a series with the Z's falling in the first two contests before winning the last two. The 'Topes will play eight games against the Zephyrs in New Orleans before playing their first contest against the Z's in Albuquerque on June 19. While hitting is always at a premium in the Big Easy, catcher Tim Federowicz batted a team-high .333 (3x12) against the Zephyrs in the previous series with a double and two RBI.

CLOSE SHAVES: With back-to-back two-run wins against the RedHawks, the Isotopes continue to be excellent in close contests. Albuquerque leads the PCL in winning percentage in both one-run and two-run games, going 12-5 (.706) in one-run contests and 7-1 (.875) in two-run affairs.

FOR WHOM THE BELL TOLLES: Reliever Shawn Tolleson has settled into a nice groove, racking up three straight scoreless outings in which he's not allowed a hit and struck out six in 4.0 innings. The right-handed Tolleson has been particularly tough on lefties, whom he's held to a .167 (3x18) batting average.

FIELDS OF DREAMS: Josh Fields has collected a hit in all but two of the 22 games he's started in the month of May while racking up hits in each of his last 13 starts, a span in which he's batted .327 (18x55) with 11 runs, and six doubles.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Will Savage makes the start coming off his first loss of the season after allowing a season-high seven runs on four hits in 4.0 innings while walking four and striking out three in 12-5 loss to Fresno on May 24. Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories equaling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP). Entered the game on April 18 vs. Iowa in the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected and pitched a then-season-high 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out two to earn his third victory of the season.

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 9.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22 at Lansing.

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer runs in 15 of them.

Saw action in just six games for Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization in 2008 before going on the Disabled List with a right elbow injury... diagnosed with a slight tear in the ulnar collateral ligament but did not require surgery.

Played the entire 2007 season with Single-A Clearwater, going 4-3 with a 3.63 ERA (25 ER / 62.0) and three saves in a career-high 42 relief appearances... 14 of his appearances were 2.0 innings or longer... in nine appearances in June went 1-1 with a 0.60 ERA (1 ER / 15.0 IP) and two saves.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: William P. Savage... attended El Camino Real High School in the San Fernando Valley... played college ball at the University of Oklahoma... attended College of the Canyons JC (Valencia, CA) where he played baseball and football... in 2003, quarterbacked the COC football team to a championship and the program's first undefeated season, going 10-0.
