'TOPES HAND-ED 4-1 LOSS TO ZEPHYRS: The Albuquerque Isotopes were no-hit into the eighth by New Orleans Zephyrs starter Brad Hand until Tim Federowicz busted it up with a solo homer, but it proved to not be enough as the 'Topes fell 4-1 to the Z's Tuesday night at Zephyr Field. Hand was magnificent, holding the 'Topes to just two walks through 7.1 innings, retiring 16 Albuquerque batters in a row from the third into the eighth until Federowicz hammered a Hand offering over the fence in deep center to break up the no-hitter and the shutout with one swing. New Orleans jumped out to a quick lead in the first when 'Topes pitcher Will Savage started the game by issuing a walk to Kevin Mattison and hitting Gil Velazquez, putting two on for Gaby Sanchez, who roped a single to left, plating Mattison and putting the home team on top 1-0. Former 'Tope Nick Green then laced a single to left, scoring Velazquez and doubling the lead to 2-0 Z's. The Zephyrs added to their advantage in the fourth, in a rally ignited by a lead-off double by Mike Cervanek and a walk to Matt Dominguez. With two down, Jose Duarte singled to right, scoring Cervanek and increasing the lead to 3-0. Pitcher Hand then capped the two-out rally with a single to center, sending home Dominguez and giving the Z's a 4-0 lead. Federowicz's big fly trimmed the lead to 4-1, but New Orleans held the burgeoning Isotopes rally right there, as reliever Rob Delaney finished off the eighth before handing the ball to closer Sandy Rosario, who pitched a perfect ninth to seal the 4-1 New Orleans win.

BACK TO THE SCENE OF THE GEM: Stephen Fife takes the mound in the New Orleans for the first time since authoring his best outing of the season against the Zephyrs there on April 29. In that outing, the right-hander delivered six scoreless frames in which he allowed just two hits while walking two and striking out three in a 5-2 Isotopes win. In fact, that outing put Fife on a roll, as he followed that start up with seven scoreless frames against Nashville on May 4 in which he allowed just three hits in what ended up being back-to-back wins. The right-hander hopes history repeats itself tonight, as since that start against Nashville, he's gone 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (17 ER / 22.2 IP) in his last four starts.

TWO-HIT TANGO: Last night the Isotopes were held to two hits for just the seventh time ever and for the first time since April 11, 2009, when Albuquerque was limited to two hits against Omaha. The 'Topes have been held to two hits or less just 14 total times in team history, including two no-hitters (one of which was a perfect game on April 7, 2003 in Nashville).

HOME RUN HAPPENINGS: Even when they're being limited to two hits, the Isotopes have still been finding a way to leave the yard, as Tim Federowicz broke up a no-hitter last night by blasting a solo home run in the eighth. Albuquerque has now belted a long ball in a season-high six straight games, amassing an amazing 12 homers over that span. The 'Topes are now tied with Iowa for the third most home runs on the season with 54, behind Round Rock (61) and Oklahoma City (59).

QUICK TRIP: Last night lefty Michael Antonini saw an inning of action after returning from less than one day in Los Angeles. Antonini was recalled to the Dodgers on Monday for bullpen depth and was optioned back to the 'Topes on Tuesday when Nathan Eovaldi was activated to start in Ted Lilly's vacant rotation slot. The left-hander has been recalled twice to the Major Leagues for a total of five days and has still yet to see any game action. Antonini will now re-enter the Isotopes rotation and pitch Friday in the series-ending game at New Orleans. In other roster news, the Isotopes placed starter Mike Parisi on the DL with a right shoulder impingement, the second time he's landed on the shelf with that ailment this season, and called up right-handed reliever Bret Montgomery from Double-A Chattanooga.

OPENING STANZA: With two runs surrendered last night, the Isotopes have conceded first-inning runs in three of their last four games. On the season, the 'Topes have been outscored 34-29 in the first inning and 75-57 in the first two innings combined.

TODAY'S START: Stephen Fife takes the mound coming off a tough outing on May 25 vs. Oklahoma City when he allowed a season-high seven runs on eight hits in 4.2 innings in a 10-4 'Topes loss. Had his best performance of the season on May 4 vs. Nashville when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings to extend his streak to 13.0 consecutive innings, fanning a season-high seven in 'Topes win. Had a strong start on April 29 at New Orleans when he tossed 6.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out three in a 5-2 'Topes triumph. Tied a franchise record by walking eight batters in just 4.2 innings on April 22 at Oklahoma City while allowing five runs on seven hits in an eventual 11-10 'Topes win 14 innings. The eight walks ties knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha Royals in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. Enjoyed his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with Double-A Chattanooga and Double-A Portland... set new career-bests in wins, innings pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for second-most in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Binghamton... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2010, his first season with Double-A Portland, he paced the club in wins (8), starts (26), and innings (136.1) while finishing third on the team with 82 strikeouts... named to the Eastern League's midseason All-Star Team after going 5-2 with a 3.83 ERA before the break... selected as the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for August 30-Sept. 6 after going 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) and seven strikeouts in two starts... limited left-handed opposition to a .248 batting average... went 3-1 with a 3.05 ERA (22 ER/65.0 IP) in 12 road starts.

In 2009, combined to go 3-5 with a 3.71 ERA (36 ER / 87.1 IP) in 18 starts with Single-A Greenville and Single-A Salem... began the season with Greenville where despite going winless in eight starts, he posted a 2.70 ERA (11 ER / 36.2 IP) with 35 strikeouts and just four walks... finished the year tops amongst Boston's farm system (min. 30.0 IP) with a combined 6.14 strikeout-to-walk ratio (86 K / 14 BB)... allowed just one home run in 36.0 innings pitched with the Drive... went 1-0 with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER / 17.2 IP) in three July starts after his promotion to Salem.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
