ISOTOPES BATTERED BY 'BIRDS, 9-5: The Albuquerque Isotopes ran into a one-man wrecking crew in the person of Matt Adams, who went 4-for-5 with two homers and five RBI to lead the Memphis Redbirds to a 9-5 win Friday night at AutoZone Park. Memphis surged ahead in the first courtesy of a two-run homer by Adams to give the 'Birds a quick 2-0 lead before the Isotopes responded in the top of the second when Tyler Henson roped a two-out RBI single, cutting the Redbirds lead to 2-1. After the 'Birds scored again in the bottom of the second, the 'Topes answered in the top of the third when Trent Oeltjen smashed a solo homer to right, keeping Albuquerque within one run at 3-2. Things got off hand for the 'Topes in the bottom of the fourth, as Memphis blew the game open with a four-spot, executed entirely with two outs to seize a 7-2 advantage. The Redbirds added some insurance thanks to Adams, who added his second two-run homer in the bottom of the sixth to give Memphis a 9-2 cushion. Albuquerque attempted to get off the mat in the seventh, when Oeltjen drew a bases-loaded walk and Brian Cavazos-Galvez lifted a sacrifice fly to right that trimmed the lead to 9-4. Finally, Cruz smashed a solo homer to left in the eighth to bring the 'Topes within 9-5, but that's as close as the visitors would get in the 9-5 Memphis victory.

THIS ONE GOES TO 11: Righty Will Savage takes the mound looking for his PCL-leading 11th victory while simultaneously going for his fourth straight win, tying his season-long as a starter. If Savage reaches the 11-win milestone, it will tie him for the fourth most in a season by an Isotopes pitcher, accomplished previously by Jeff Fulchino in 2005 and Charlie Haeger in 2009. The season is just over the half-way mark and Savage is already poised to destroy the franchise record for wins in a season of 13, set by Frankie De La Cruz in 2008 and equaled by Giancarlo Alvarado in 2009. Tonight, the right-hander returns to where it all began. On April 6, Savage won his first game of the season in the Isotopes' first win of the season after tossing 2.0 innings of relief in a 5-2 victory at Werner Park.

SOMEWHERE IN MIDDLE AMERICA: The Isotopes arrive in Omaha for their second and final visit of the 2012 season looking to prove themselves against the Pacific Coast League's best team. The last time Albuquerque visited Werner Park was way back on April 5-8 when the 'Topes opened the 2012 season by dropping three of four games to the Chasers. In eight total games against Omaha this season, the Isotopes are 3-5, making the Storm Chasers one of just two teams in the PCL's American Conference against whom the 'Topes have a losing record (Round Rock, 3-4). Like he has a lot of teams, Luis Cruz has feasted on Omaha pitching, batting .464 (13x28) with three doubles, a triple, and seven RBI in seven games.

THE ANGLE ON MATT: With two hits last night in Memphis, Matt Angle has collected a hit in each of his last eight games, and multiple hits six times over that span. Since June 21, Angle is batting a blistering .455 (15x33). The outfielder has also scored in each of his last eight contests, racking up nine runs with nine RBI. Angle has also been doing damage lower in the lineup, batting .325 (26x80) in 21 total games when hitting out of the seventh or eighth positions.

HOMER HAPPY: Over their last six games, the Isotopes have belted nine home runs, including five in their just-completed three-game set in Memphis. Not only is Albuquerque racking up long balls, but the wealth is being spread around, as the nine homers hit since June 24 have been provided by eight different players. Only Jerry Sands has collected more than one home run in that span. On the season, the Isotopes have 85 dingers, third-most in the PCL.

NEXT STOP- THE FOURTH: After a road trip to Omaha, the Isotopes are back home on July 4 for a spectacular Independence Day celebration in which fans will be allowed to watch the annual fireworks show from the field. Adding to the festive atmosphere will be the classic rock cover band Stratus Phear, which will play live from 4:45-5:00 PM at Captain's Corner. On July 6, fan favorite Myron Noodleman will be on hand to make one of his never-tedious appearances!

TODAY'S START: Will Savage makes the start looking for his 11th win of the season and his fourth victory in a row after earning the win on June 25 vs. Nashville after allowing four runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings while walking one and striking out three in an 11-9 'Topes triumph. Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories equaling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP). Entered the game on April 18 vs. Iowa in the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected and pitched a then-season-high 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out two to earn his third victory of the season.

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 9.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22 at Lansing.

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer earned runs in 15 of them.

Saw action in just six games for Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization in 2008 before going on the Disabled List with a right elbow injury... diagnosed with a slight tear in the ulnar collateral ligament but did not require surgery.

Played the entire 2007 season with Single-A Clearwater, going 4-3 with a 3.63 ERA (25 ER / 62.0) and three saves in a career-high 42 relief appearances... 14 of his appearances were 2.0 innings or longer... in nine appearances in June went 1-1 with a 0.60 ERA (1 ER / 15.0 IP) and two saves.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: William P. Savage... attended El Camino Real High School in the San Fernando Valley... played college ball at the University of Oklahoma... attended College of the Canyons JC (Valencia, CA) where he played baseball and football... in 2003, quarterbacked the COC football team to a championship and the program's first undefeated season, going 10-0.
