CASTELLANOS, 'TOPES POUND SOUNDS 13-3: Alex Castellanos drove in a season-high five runs and Jerry Sands added four hits as the Albuquerque Isotopes erupted for 12 runs over the final four innings to cruise to a 13-3 thrashing of the Nashville Sounds Saturday night at Greer Stadium. Albuquerque spotted the Sounds a pair of runs, one in the first and another in the second, before the Isotopes got on the board courtesy of a solo homer by Sands to lead off the fourth that cut the deficit to 2-1. The 'Topes grabbed a strangle-hold on the contest in the sixth thanks to a five-run frame executed with two outs. With the bases loaded and two down, Elian Herrera roped a single to center that scored two to give Albuquerque a 3-2 edge. Tim Dillard then came in to relieve Sounds starter Brian Baker and immediately surrendered a three-run shot to Castellanos that helped the 'Topes extend the lead to 6-2. Nashville got one run back in the bottom of the sixth to make the score 6-3, but the Isotopes added three more in the seventh to seize a 9-3 cushion. At that point the rout was on, as Albuquerque added two more in the eighth before Castellanos put the exclamation point on the evening in the ninth. With Herrera on first, the 'Topes third baseman hammered a two-run blast deep over the wall in center to send the Isotopes to a 13-3 triumph.

A PAIR OF HOT HURLERS: In today's doubleheader the Isotopes will send a pair of pitchers to the mound that have won six straight games between them. In the first contests, Derrick Loop takes the hill with a four-game winning streak and is coming off his best of the start of the season, which happened to be a no-decision. On July 24 at Round Rock, Loop tossed a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing just one run on five hits while walking one and striking out a season-high five. Loop wasn't around the when contest was decided however, as the Express prevailed in 11-innings 5-4. In game two, the 'Topes will trot out Blake Johnson, who has earned a victory in each of his last appearances. After getting a win in a spot-start vs. Iowa on July 21 when he fired 5.0 frames, allowing three runs on five hits while walking two and striking out three in a 16-3 Isotopes pounding the Cubs, Johnson authored 2.0 perfect frames four days later on July 25 at Round Rock in a 6-5 Albuquerque win in 13 innings. Johnson's victory turned out to be the Isotopes' only win in four games against the Express in the two teams' just-completed series.

LET'S PLAY TWO!: For the second time in exactly two weeks, the 'Topes and Sounds will square off in a doubleheader at Greer Stadium. In their first twin-bill on July 15, the Sounds grabbed the first game 2-1 thanks to a walk-off homer by Logan Schafer, but Albuquerque roared back in the second game thanks to an eight-run sixth to take an 8-5 victory. This will be Albuquerque's third doubleheader of the season, as the 'Topes also split a twin-bill with Memphis at Isotopes Park on July 19.

THE CASTY MAN CAN: With a pair of homers and five RBI last night, Alex Castellanos continues to swing a hot bat, racking up hits in each of his last seven games, a span in which he's batting .419 (13x31) with six runs, two doubles, four homers, and 10 RBI. In those seven games, Castellanos has had three, three-hit performances, including his three-knock game last night.

DOUBLE-DIGIT PITCHERS: With John Ely's victory last night, the Isotopes now have two pitchers with double-digit win totals with the possibility of one more added tonight. Ely and Will Savage now have 10 wins for the 'Topes, while tonight's game one starter Derrick Loop has nine victories. The Isotopes have never had three pitchers win 10 games or more in a single season, but have come close three times. In 2009, Giancarlo Alvarado (13) and Charlie Haeger (11) reached double-digits while reliever Hyang-Nam Choi reached nine wins. In 2008, Frankie De La Cruz (13) and Chris Seddon (10) reached the 10-win threshold while Bobby Keppel finished with nine victories and in 2005 Jeff Fulchino reached 11 wins while Frank Castillo and Ariel Prieto each had nine.

THE LAB HEATS UP IN AUGUST: After an eight-game road trip, the Isotopes are back home on August 1 to start the final month of the regular season in style. On tap for the eight-game homestand is cowbell night, a performance by the Zooperstars!, fireworks, and a Dodger Stadium Replica giveaway!

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop takes the mound riding a season-high four-game winning streak and coming off his best start of the season even though it resulted in a no-decision. On July 24 at Round Rock, Loop pitched a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits while walking one and striking out a season-high five. Loop didn't figure in the decision, however, as the Express won 5-4 in 11 innings. Made his first start of the season on June 28 at Memphis, his first since August 27, 2011, going 3.0 innings, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his second-career Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-season-high 4.0 innings in a win vs. Oklahoma City on May 28, the third in a string of three straight victorious decisions, also a season-high.

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater... left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 consecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a 5.29 (20 ER / 34.0 IP) in 19 games (two starts)... held left-handed hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Started the 2010 season with Camden in the Independent Atlantic League, going 0-1 with a 1.72 (6 ER / 31.1 IP) in 33 games... walked just 17 batters while striking out 40... signed with the Phillies on July 14 and began season with Single-A Clearwater... was on DL, from August 15-22... did not allow an earned run in 14 of his 15 relief appearances with Clearwater before being promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5 for his Triple-A debut... averaged 10.29 SO / 9.0 IP between both levels... held opponents to a combined .165 avg (15x91)... played for Aguilas in Dominican Winter League (16 G, 1-1, 2.79 ERA).

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fourth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June 25... set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Derrick A. Loop... attended Norco High School in Norco, California before playing college baseball at California State University - Los Angeles.

TODAY'S START: Blake Johnson makes his third start of the season coming off wins in back-to-back appearances. The right-hander got his first win of the season on July 21 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.0 frames, allowing three runs on five hits while walking two and striking out three in a 16-3 Topes thrashing of the Cubs. Four days later, Johnson picked up a win in relief on July 25 at Round Rock, pitching two perfect frames in a 6-5 Albuquerque win in 13 innings. Made his first start of the season in the second game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 15, his first start since May 10, 2011 when he pitched for the Omaha Storm Chasers. Used exclusively as a reliever in his first 11 appearances for the Isotopes, the right-hander posted back-to-back scoreless appearances on July 6 and July 8 in which he tossed 2.0 frames without surrendering any hits while fanning two. Did not allow a ball to leave the yard in a five game stretch (5.1 IP) from June 26-July 8.

Promoted to Albuquerque on June 7 from Double-A Chattanooga, where he went 2-3 with a 3.38 ERA (11 ER / 29.1 IP) and one save in 21 relief appearances. Held opposing Southern League hitters to a .227 (25x110) batting average.

2011: Appeared in 43 combined games (one start), earning a 6-2 record with a 5.59 ERA in the Royals and Rockies organizations, transitioning to the bullpen full-time after making 131 starts in his previous six professional seasons... Gave up only six homers through 77.1 innings of combined work... totaled a 2-1 record with 7.62 ERA through 20 games (26.0 IP) with Colorado Springs... allowed two runs or less in 17 of 20 appearances with Sky Sox... posted a 3-1 record with one save in 30.1 frames with Omaha... made three consecutive appearances (8 IP) without allowing a run from May 24-31 for Storm Chasers... limited left-handed hitters to only five extra-base hits in 52 at-bats with Omaha... opened the season with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, picking up three saves and posting a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP)

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began the 2010 season with Northwest Arkansas, going 5-3 in 80.1 innings pitched over 23 games (10 starts)...also appeared in six games (one start) for Triple-A Omaha, allowing 1 ER or less in four of his six outings... tossed 51.1 innings with a 4-2 record and 2.63 ERA in second half of the season... pitched effectively against left-handed bats, limiting them to a .274 average with no triples or home runs, and 26 strikeouts to just eight walks... posted a 2-1 record with one save and 1.29 ERA (28.0 IP) in August, holding opposing sticks to .253 average.

Won eight games in 24 starts with Northwest Arkansas in 2009, ranking second on the team... his 4.57 ERA was second lowest among team pitchers with at least 81 innings of work, and his 122.0 frames ranked third among all Naturals... finished the season with 61 punch outs, third most on the team... tossed a one-hitter shutout through 6.0 innings in a win vs. Springfield on April 23... won three straight decisions from June 13-July 12... fanned a season-high seven through 6.1 innings on July 28 at Tulsa.

Spent entire 2008 season with Northwest Arkansas... tied for the team lead, and tied third in Texas League with 10 wins in 26 games (25 starts)... named to Texas League mid-season All-Star team... walked just 38 batters to 86 strikeouts in 143.0 innings of work... ranked third on the Naturals in innings pitched... hurled six innings or more in four consecutive starts from May 4-19, a span in which we went a perfect 3-0... had two spans where he won four straight decisions from May 4-25 and June 29-Aug-1.

In 2007, helped Single-A Wilimngton reach the playoffs, going 9-6 with 3.28 ERA in 26 games (22 starts) and allowing just 119 hits and 33 walks in 131.2 innings of work (1.15 WHIP)... finished ranked third on team in both wins and innings pitched... tossed 10.1 innings in relief with a .087 ERA out of the pen and one save... surrendered only seven long balls in 536 batters faced, good for just one homer every 77 batters... undefeated in second-half games, winning final six decisions from June 21-Sept 1, a span in which he posted 1.28 ERA and allowed no earned runs in five of the six wins

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Blake Wayne Johnson... Originally selected by the Dodgers in the second round of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft... graduated from Parkview Baptist High in Baton Rouge, La. ... was 8-3 with a 1.31 ERA in 12 games as a senior in 2004... struck out 116 batters, allowing just 15 walks and 39 hits in 64 innings.
