HISTORIC NIGHT BY SANDS SENDS 'TOPES TO DOUBLEHEADER SWEEP: After driving in the game-winning runs in the first contest, Jerry Sands erupted for a Pacific Coast League record-tying two grand slams in the night-cap to lead the Albuquerque Isotopes to a doubleheader sweep of the Nashville Sounds, 4-2 (8 innings) and 11-0, Sunday night at Greer Stadium. Sands' assault on the record books started early in the second game, as the slugger crushed his first grand slam of the season in the bottom of the first to give Albuquerque a quick 4-0 lead. That proved to be just a warm-up, as the 'Topes, again thanks to Sands, blew the game open with a six-run fourth. With the bases loaded and one out, Scott Van Slyke drew a walk that gave Albuquerque a 5-0 cushion. That set up Sands, who then hammered his second slam of the game, extending the Isotopes' lead to a commanding 9-0. After a groundout, Tyler Henson capped the big inning with a solo shot of his own, extending the visitors' lead to 10-0 as Albuquerque coasted to an 11-0 win. Sands' superb second game was set up by the outfielder playing hero in the first contest as well. With the game knotted at 2-2 in the top of the eighth inning, Trent Oeltjen and Elian Herrera led off the frame by each getting hit by a pitch. Van Slyke drew a walk that loaded the bases, familiar territory for Sands, who ripped a double down the right-field line, scoring two and giving the 'Topes a 4-2 lead. Albuquerque closer Josh Wall would make things interesting in the bottom of the eighth, loading the bases on an error and two walks, but the 'Topes closer was up to the challenge, coaxing a pop-out before striking out the next two batters to secure a 4-2 extra-inning, game one triumph.

BACK TO THE SCENE OF THE GEM: Tonight Fernando Nieve returns to Greer Stadium, scene of perhaps his best start of the season. On July 13, Nieve held the Sounds to just four hits through 6.0 strong innings in which he walked two and struck out six en route to his fifth win of the year. That performance has kick-started an excellent stretch for the right-hander, who has posted a 1.69 ERA (3 ER / 16.0 IP) in three starts since the All-Star Break. In four starts in the month of July, Nieve has an ERA of 2.05 (5 ER / 22.0 IP) third-lowest of any starter in the PCL this month.

HISTORY BOOKS: With his huge game last night, Jerry Sands becomes just the fifth player in the 109-year history of the Pacific Coast League to hit two grand slams in one game, joining Pete Schneider (1923), Babe Pinelli (1929), A.J. Pierzynski (2000), and Gregorio

Petit (2010). Sands also becomes just the third person in the history of Triple-A baseball in Albuquerque to drive in eight runs in a single game, joining Paul Konerko, who accomplished the feat for the Dukes in 1997, and Gerald Williams, who had eight RBI for the 'Topes almost nine years to the day before Sands' feat, July 28, 2003. There have only been 13 players in the Major League history to hit two bases-loaded home runs in a single game, with the last player to do it also having Isotope ties. On July 27, 2009, Josh Willingham, who played for the 'Topes in 2005, hit two slams for the Nationals against the Brewers.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: In a development that is about as surprising as the sun rising in the east, Sands has been named Pacific Coast League Player of the Week for his historic game last night, but also for the body of his work since July 23. In his last seven contests, Sands is batting .375 (12x32) with five runs, a double, three homers (two slams), and 11 RBI, 10 of which were knocked in last night during both games of the doubleheader combined. Sands is the second Isotope to be singled out for the PCL weekly accolade, joining Alex Castellanos, who won the award for the week of April 22.

SWEET MUSIC: With a record of 11-3 in 14 games against the Sounds, the Isotopes will finish 2012 with their best season-series record against Nashville regardless of what happens in the next two games. Albuquerque's previous best record against the Sounds was 10-6, set last year. A win in the next two games would give the 'Topes six victories at Greer Stadium this season, also a franchise best.

THE LAB HEATS UP IN AUGUST: After an eight-game road trip, the Isotopes are back home Wednesday to start the final month of the regular season in style. On tap for the eight-game homestand is cowbell night, a performance by the Zooperstars!, fireworks, and a Dodger Stadium Replica giveaway!

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve makes the start coming off his second straight solid no-decision on July 25 at Round Rock when he worked 5.0 innings, allowing four runs, two earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out five in an eventual 6-5 'Topes win in 13 innings. Pitched 6.0 shutout innings on July 13 at Nashville, his second shutout performance of the season, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out six in a 7-0 'Topes win. The victory was his second in as many starts. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The right-hander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11 'Topes loss.

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a 7.63 ERA (13 ER / 15.1 IP)... granted his release on April 27.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the majority of the 2010 season with New York (NL)... was Designated for Assignment on July 23rd and optioned to Triple-A Buffalo on July 27... made 40 appearances for New York and had one start, May 29 at Milwaukee, an 8-6 loss... in 2.0 innings, he gave up three hits, five runs, all earned, with three walks and five strikeouts... became the first pitcher in Mets franchise history to appear in 19 of the team's first 30 games... picked up victories in relief vs. the Cubs on April 19 (1.1 scoreless innings with one hit) and vs. Detroit at Citi Field on June 22 (2.1 innings, no hits, no runs, with a walk and four strikeouts)... in seven June games, went 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA (3 ER / 8.2 IP and eight hits)... worked a career-best 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings in nine appearances from April 17-May 3, giving up five hits, with three walks and 10 strikeouts... struck out a season-high four in 2.1 innings vs. Detroit on June 22... went a season-best 3.0 innings vs. Cincinnati on July 5, permitting one run on three hits... made eight straight starts for Buffalo upon his return to the Bisons... scored backto-back victories against Scranton Wilkes-Barre on August 11 and against Pawtucket on August 16... went at least 6.0 innings in four of his eight Triple-A starts.

In 2009 went to Spring Training with Houston... was claimed off waivers by New York (NL) on March 13 and assigned to Double-A Binghamton... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on May 18 and had his contract purchased by the Mets on June 5... placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 20 with a muscle tear in his right thigh and did not pitch for the rest of the season... tore the muscle during his start on July 19 at Atlanta... finished the season with the best ERA of his career (2.95)... Major League batters went hitless against him with runners in scoring position and two out (0-for-10)... made his Mets debut on June 6 with 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 7-1 loss at Washington, allowing one hit and striking out two... beat St. Louis with 6.0 shutout innings on June 24 at home to establish a career-best three game winning streak... became the first Mets pitcher to win his first three starts with the team since Jorge Sosa in 2007... also tied his career-best scoreless streak with the 6.0 shutout innings on June 24.
