ISOTOPES SURGE PAST REDBIRDS, 6-3: The Albuquerque Isotopes plated three runs in the top of the ninth to break a 3-3 tie and surge to a 6-3 win over the Memphis Redbirds Thursday night at AutoZone Park. With the game tied at 3-3 in the ninth, Josh Bard ignited a ‘Topes rally with a lead-off single and was replaced by pinch-runner Matt Angle. The insertion of the speedy baserunner proved prescient, as Angle scampered into scoring position on a sacrifice bunt by Ozzie Martinez. Redbirds reliever Victor Marte then intentionally walked Tony Gwynn Jr. before walking Elian Herrera, loading the bases with just one down. After a strikeout brought Albuquerque to its final out, Marte unleashed a wild pitch, allowing the speedy Angle to score and give the ‘Topes a 4-3 edge. Jerry Sands then added some insurance, poking a single that barely squeaked through the infield into left, scoring Gwynn and Herrera to boost the visitor’s advantage to 6-3. That was plenty for All-Star closer Josh Wall, who came on in the bottom of the ninth and, after allowing a single and a ground-rule double, coaxed Bryan Anderson into a groundout to second, preserving the 6-3 win as well as securing his PCL-leading 26th save of the season.

THROWING FOR A LOOP: Lefty Derrick Loop makes the start looking to build off a sensational outing in his last appearance on August 19. In a huge game against division-rival New Orleans, Loop delivered 6.2 scoreless innings in which he allowed just three hits and three walks while striking out four in a 6-0 ‘Topes shutout win. The left-hander has now won 11 games this season, one shy of the 12 total victories he racked up in 2009 through 2011 combined. Since joining the rotation (coincidentally in Memphis on June 28), Loop has been a revelation, going 5-1 with a 5.10 ERA (19 ER / 42.2 IP) and five of his 10 starts this year have been quality starts, including four of his last six. In his last start against the Redbirds, the first game of a doubleheader on July 19 at Isotopes Park, Loop pitched 6.0 solid innings, allowing just one run on three hits while walking one and striking out four in a 4-3 ‘Topes triumph in seven innings.

CENTURY CLUB: With his three runs batted in last night, Jerry Sands has increased his season total to 101 on the year, becoming just the third Isotope to ever reach the century mark in RBI. In 2007, Scott Seabol set the standard with 105 driven in and in 2009 slugger Mitch Jones knocked in 103 runs. Sands leads the Pacific Coast League with 25 RBI in the month of August over just 18 games and is within range of the team record of 32 RBI in a month, set by Jason Stokes in August, 2005, and equaled by Tagg Bozied in August, 2008.

A DEE-LIGHTFUL ADDITION: One of the most popular players to ever suit up for the Isotopes is back, as shortstop Dee Gordon joins Albuquerque today on a Major League Rehabilitation Assignment. On July 4 in the eighth inning of a game against Cincinnati at Chavez Ravine, Gordon tore a ligament in his right thumb sliding into third base and was placed on the DL the next day. Prior to getting injured, Gordon was batting .229 (69x301) with 30 steals in 38 tries over 78 total games. Last season, the speedy shortstop was sensational, batting .333 (96x288) in 70 games with the Isotopes before making his Major League debut. In 56 games with Los Angeles last year, Gordon batted .304 (68x224), the fifth-highest average ever for an LA Dodgers rookie.

MAGIC EIGHT BALL: By virtue of the Isotopes win last night and a loss by New Orleans in Omaha, the ‘Topes now have a 4.0 game lead in the PCL’s American Southern Division with 11 contests to play, reducing the team’s Magic Number to eight. Oklahoma City continues to make up ground and after winning seven of its last 10, is just 5.5 games behind Albuquerque.

THE LAST WALTZ: Exactly one week from tonight the Isotopes return for their final regular season series of the year, a four-game set against Omaha that is packed with fun. It all starts on Friday with a special Salute to Orbit, where the loveable ‘Topes mascot will get presented his Mascot Mania Championship Belt! Fans are invited to get their picture taken with Orbit throughout the night. After the game, the skies will light up with the first of three straight fireworks shows!

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop takes the mound coming off his 11th win of the season, a stellar outing vs. New Orleans on August 19 when he pitched 6.2 shutout innings, allowing just three hits and three walks while striking out four in a 6-0 Isotopes win. Became the third Isotopes pitcher to earn double-digit wins this season after steering the 'Topes to a 7-2 victory over Tucson in the second game of a twin-bill on August 9, allowing just two runs on three hits through 6.0 frames, while fanning five and walking two. Had his best start of the season even though it resulted in a no-decision on July 24 at Round Rock when he pitched a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits while walking one and striking out a season-high five. Loop didn't figure in the decision, however, as the Express won 5-4 in 11 innings. Made his first start of the season on June 28 at Memphis, his first since August 27, 2011, going 3.0 innings, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his second-career Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-season-high 4.0 innings in a win vs. Oklahoma City on May 28, the third in a string of three straight victorious decisions, also a season-high.

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater... left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 consecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a 5.29 (20 ER / 34.0 IP) in 19 games (two starts)... held left-handed hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Started the 2010 season with Camden in the Independent Atlantic League, going 0-1 with a 1.72 (6 ER / 31.1 IP) in 33 games... walked just 17 batters while striking out 40... signed with the Phillies on July 14 and began season with Single-A Clearwater... was on DL, from August 15-22... did not allow an earned run in 14 of his 15 relief appearances with Clearwater before being promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5 for his Triple-A debut... averaged 10.29 SO / 9.0 IP between both levels... held opponents to a combined .165 avg (15x91)... played for Aguilas in Dominican Winter League (16 G, 1-1, 2.79 ERA).

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fourth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June 25... set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Derrick A. Loop... attended Norco High School in Norco, California before playing college baseball at California State University - Los Angeles.
