SANDS SPARKS ‘TOPES TO 4-2 WIN OVER MEMPHIS: With trade rumors swirling around him for a stretch of 36 hours, Jerry Sands delivered a two-run homer in his first at-bat that propelled the Albuquerque Isotopes to a thrilling 4-2 win over the Memphis Redbirds on Saturday night at AutoZone Park. After Josh Fields hit a one-out single in the top of the first inning, Sands wasted little time announcing to the PCL that the league’s most ferocious hitter hadn’t gone anywhere, crushing a two-run homer over the wall in left to give Albuquerque a 2-0 edge. The ‘Topes added to their lead in the third when Scott Van Slyke slapped an RBI single to center, increasing the visitor’s lead to 3-0. Memphis would answer in the bottom of the third thanks to a two-run homer by Steven Hill, bringing the ‘Birds within a run at 3-2. Albuquerque added an always important run of insurance in the top of the eighth when Van Slyke poked a ground ball up the middle that deflected off the glove of shortstop Pete Kozma and trickled into centerfield just off the infield dirt. After noticing that nobody was covering second base, Van Slyke alertly chugged around first and slid into second with an infield double. The hustle play set up Tim Federowicz, who lined a single into center that plated Van Slyke and bolstered the ‘Topes’ lead to 4-2. The plucky ‘Birds would try mount a comeback in the eighth, putting the tying run on base with nobody out, but reliever Javy Guerra escaped the jam and handed the baton to closer Josh Wall, who authored a scoreless ninth to secure the 4-2 Isotopes win.

THE MOUND IS HIS FIFE-DOM: Stephen Fife takes the mound coming off his 10th win of the season after a dominating performance on August 21 against the New Orleans. In that start, Fife pitched 6.0 strong innings, allowing just two runs, one of which was earned, on eight hits while walking one and striking out three in a 6-4 Isotopes win. The 10 wins marks the second-most the right-hander has racked up in a season over his five-year professional career. Last year, Fife won 11 games for Double-A Portland in the Boston chain before he was traded to the Dodgers organization and won three more games for Chattanooga for a total of 14. Prior to that, the most games Fife had won in a single season was eight for Portland in 2010. Strangely enough, Fife has suddenly shown a slight susceptibility to the long ball. The right-hander has given up a home run in each of his last three outings after allowing five total home runs in his first 20 appearances.

THE BLOCKBUSTER: The mammoth trade between the Dodgers and Red Sox managed to impact the Isotopes as well, as Ivan De Jesus Jr. was sent to the Boston organization yesterday along with first baseman James Loney, right-handed pitcher Allen Webster, and two players to be named later. De Jesus was assigned to Triple-A Pawtucket and was immediately put in the starting lineup, playing second base and batting second as the Paw-Sox took on the Charlotte Knights in Charlotte. De Jesus is a member of the Red Sox 40-man roster and is eligible to be called up when rosters expand on September 1. Playing center field for Pawtucket today is another former Isotope, Jason Repko.

CORKY’S BACK!: It just wouldn’t be an Isotopes season without a member of the Corcoran family on the roster! Yesterday, the ‘Topes added Tim Corcoran to the bullpen after the Dodgers signed him from Carmen in the Mexican League. The right-hander, who missed all of last year recovering from Tommy John surgery, pitched well for Carmen, going 7-4 with a 2.50 ERA (26 ER / 93.2 IP) in 16 games (14 starts). This will be the sixth straight season the Isotopes have had either Tim or his brother Roy Corcoran on the roster. Tim pitched in Albuquerque in 2008, 2009, and 2010, while Roy pitched for the ‘Topes in 2007 and 2011.

IT’S MAGIC: With last night’s win and a New Orleans loss at Omaha, the Isotopes lead in the PCL’s American Southern Division is now 4.0 games with nine to play. Since Albuquerque holds the tie breaker against the Z’s, the ‘Topes magic number to win the division is just five. Albuquerque’s magic number to eliminate Oklahoma City is down to just three as the RedHawks are now 6.5 games back.

THE LAST WALTZ: Next Friday, the Isotopes return for their final regular season series of the year, a four-game set against Omaha that is packed with fun. It all starts on Friday with a special Salute to Orbit, where the loveable ‘Topes mascot will get presented his Mascot Mania Championship Belt! Fans are invited to get their picture taken with Orbit throughout the night. After the game, the skies will light up with the first of three straight fireworks shows!

TODAY'S START: Stephen Fife takes the mound coming off his 10th win of the season vs. New Orleans on August 21 when he allowed just two runs, one of them earned, on eight hits in 6.0 innings while walking one and striking out three in a 6-4 'Topes win. Had a three-game winning from July 6-August 11, his second such streak of the season. Returned on August 6 from a brief stay with the Dodgers, with whom he made a pair of starts. Suffered his first big league defeat on August 1 vs. Arizona, when he pitched 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on six hits while walking three and striking out four in a 4-0 Dodgers loss. Had a solid no-decision at San Francisco on July 27, pitching 6.1 innings and allowing one run on six hits while walking three and striking out two in a 5-3 LA win in 10 innings. Fanned a season-high 12 on July 22 vs. Iowa, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings in a 9-5 loss. Made his Major League debut with Los Angeles on July 17, when the right-hander filled in for an injured Chad Billingsley. Facing the Philadelphia Phillies, Fife pitched 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits and three walks while striking out one. Fife left with a 2-1 lead and in line to get the win, but the Phillies rallied for two runs in the eighth to grab a 3-2 win. The right-hander held the Phillies' quartet of All-Star players Jimmy Rollins, Chase Utley, Ryan Howard, and Carlos Ruiz to a combined 1-for-11. Had his best outing of the season on July 6 vs. Round Rock, when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in which he allowed just two hits and two walks while striking out two in a 10-1 'Topes win. Won three straight decisions for the second time this season from May 30 to June 26, posting a 1.50 ERA (3 ER / 18.0 IP) in those starts. Had a shut-out performance on May 30 in New Orleans when he tossed 6.0 scoreless frames, allowing seven hits and a walk while striking out five in a 4-0 'Topes win. In two starts at New Orleans this year, did not allow a run in 12.0 innings. Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on May 4 vs. Nashville to extend his streak to 13.0 consecutive innings, fanning a season-high seven in an 8-1 'Topes win. Tied a franchise record by walking eight batters in just 4.2 innings on April 22 at Oklahoma City while allowing five runs on seven hits in an eventual 11-10 'Topes win 14 innings. The eight walks ties knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha Royals in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. Enjoyed his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with Double-A Chattanooga and Double-A Portland... set new career-bests in wins, innings pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for second-most in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Binghamton... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
