## ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (77-60) AT OKLAHOMA CITY REDHAWKS (72-64)

**'TOPES ROUGHED UP BY REDHAWKS, 6-1:** The Albuquerque Isotopes struggled to find the scoreboard, going 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position and tallying their only run via a balk in a 6-1 loss to the Oklahoma City RedHawks Monday night at Chickasaw Ballpark. Albuquerque scored its sole run of the game in the fourth as Scott Van Slyke roped a one-out single, advanced to second on a walk, and moved to third on a flyout. With Matt Angle at the plate, 'Hawks starter Jarrod Cosart was called for a balk, sending Van Slyke home to put the 'Topes up 1-0. Starter Will Savage did everything he could to pick up his elusive 11th win, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings to help preserve the Isotopes' slim lead, but Oklahoma City capitalized on Savage's departure, pounding out four runs in the bottom of the seventh. With the bases loaded and no outs, Brad Snyder promptly ripped a two-run single to right to give the RedHawks a 2-1 edge. Matt Downs then continued the rally with a sac-fly to left, making the score 3-1, before Mike Hessmann capped the inning with a solo shot to left that extended the lead 4-1. The home team padded its lead in the eighth when Snyder again played the hero for the 'Hawks, slapping an RBI single to left-center with the bases loaded that widened the advantage 5-1. Two batters later, Hessman coaxed a bases-loaded walk that sent Oklahoma City to a 6-1 win.

**ELY-MANIA:** Record-setting ace John Ely makes what will be his second-to-last start of the 2012 regular season, looking to extend his Isotopes franchise mark with his 15th victory of the season. Not only would 15 wins be a career-high for the right-hander, it would move him into a six-way tie for the third-most wins in Albuquerque Triple-A baseball history and the most since 1990. Another victory and Ely would join Dukes luminaries as Dennis Lewallyn and Dave Stewart, who each won 15 games in Albuquerque (Lewallyn did it twice in 1976 and 1980). Ted Power has the Albuquerque Triple-A record with 18 wins in 1981 followed by three-way tie for second with 16; Rex Hudson (1974), Brian Holton (1981), and Rich Rodas (1983). Another win would also lift Ely into first place by himself in the PCL, no small feat considering the right-hander is going for the PCL pitching Triple Crown. He currently is tied for lead in the wins with Las Vegas hurler Sean O'Sullivan, but holds the outright lead in ERA (3.10) and strikeouts (162).

**ALL-PCL ALL ABOUT ALBUQUERQUE:** The 2012 All-PCL team was officially announced yesterday with one-third of the roster consisting of Isotopes players. Albuquerque's four selections - Jerry Sands, Tim Federowicz, John Ely and Josh Wall - marked the most individuals from one PCL club named to the 12-man squad, as well as the most selections in 'Topes' franchise history. Since 2003, the Isotopes have had five other players named to the All-PCL team: Robert Stratton, 2003; Mitch Jones, 2009; Scott Strickland, 2009; John Lindsey, 2010; Russ Mitchell, 2010.

**AN AUGUST OCCASION:** Despite scoring just one run in each of their last two games, the Isotopes continue to swing the hottest bats in the Pacific Coast League over the month of August. Albuquerque's team batting average this month is an impressive .308, second highest in the PCL to Round Rock's .314 mark this month.

**MAGIC TIME:** With last night's loss to the RedHawks, the 'Topes' Magic Number to win the PCL's American Southern Division remains at four, with Albuquerque hanging on to a 3.5 game lead with seven contests to play. Tonight, while the Isotope and 'Hawks battle in Oklahoma City, New Orleans will play a doubleheader at Round Rock, meaning an Albuquerque win and an Express sweep could lower the 'Topes' number all the way to one in a span of one day. The 'Hawks are also still in the mix, trailing by 4.5 games and with an elimination number of three.

**THE LAST WALTZ:** This Friday, the Isotopes return for their final regular season series of the year, a four-game set against Omaha that is packed with fun. It all starts on Friday with a special Salute to Orbit, where the loveable 'Topes mascot will get presented his Mascot Mania Championship Belt! Fans are invited to get their picture taken with Orbit throughout the night. After the game, the skies will light up with the first of three straight fireworks shows!

**TODAY'S START:** John Ely takes the mound coming off a solid no-decision at Memphis on August 23 when he pitched 7.0 innings, allowing three runs, two earned, on three hits while walking two and striking out three in a eventual 6-3 'Topes win. Named to the All-PCL team as the roster's right-handed pitcher. Won his franchise-record 14th game of the season, a dominant performance vs. New Orleans on August 18 when he pitched 8.0 innings, allowing just one run on six hits while walking two and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. The victory was also his eighth home win of the season, also a franchise record. Delivered the first complete-game shutout by a 'Topes pitcher this season after limiting Tucson to just six hits through 7.0 innings while walking one and striking out eight in a 4-0 win in the first game of a doubleheader on August 8. Selected to his first Triple-A All-Star Game and his first since he appeared as a Southern League All-Star in 2009. Pitched a scoreless fourth inning, allowing one walk and striking out two in a 3-0 PCL win. Won a season-high fourth straight game after a victory on June 22 vs. New Orleans when he allowed four runs on five hits in 6.1 innings while walking one and striking out six in an 8-4 Isotopes win in seven-innings. Came two outs away from becoming the first Isotope this season to toss a complete game but surrendered back-to-back home runs that ended his night. Had a streak of six straight quality starts from April 30-May 26. Had a dominant 3-2 win at Tacoma on May 10 when he allowed just two runs on four hits while walking three and striking out a career-high 11, shattering his old career-high of nine set in 2008 when he was at Single-A Winston-Salem in the South Atlantic League. Authored 15.0 scoreless innings in three straight home starts from April 19-May 5. Earned his first victory of 2012, a stellar start on April 19 vs. Iowa when he allowed three runs on six hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 'Topes win.

**2011:** Played most of the season in Albuquerque, going 7-8 with a 5.99 ERA (96 ER / 144.1 IP) in 25 starts... recalled on April 10 and made a spot start for the Dodgers that day at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres... optioned back to Albuquerque on April 11... nearly threw his first career no-hitter and the first no-hitter in Isotopes history in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20... after holding the I-Cubs hitless going into the seventh and final inning, he struck out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith... then retired the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career... named PCL Pitcher of the Week for April 18-25 thanks to his performance... had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career... allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in the 3-1 'Topes victory... recalled on June 4 and had a brief stay with the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing of his career - 2007 at Rookie-Level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati... entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win... if he had worked the ninth, he would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA... optioned back to Albuquerque on June 6... had a short stay with the Dodgers after being recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games before being optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7... recalled one last time on Sept. 6 and made three more relief appearances for Dodgers, not allowing a run in 4.0 innings.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut in 2010, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from Sept. 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodgers rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins.
