'TOPES TROUNCE STORM CHASERS, 11-3: Eight of nine batters collected both a hit and run scored behind a dominant performance by starter Stephen Fife as the Albuquerque Isotopes cruised to an 11-3 win over the Omaha Storm Chasers Friday night at Isotopes Park. Fife pitched a gem, allowing two runs, one earned, on six hits through 7.0 innings in which he walked one and fanned three. Albuquerque wasted no time giving its starter run support as Bobby Abreu coaxed a one-out walk in the bottom of the first and scored when Josh Fields hammered a triple to deep right field, putting the 'Topes up 1-0. Fields then raced home on a sac-fly from Jerry Sands, narrowly avoiding the tag at the plate to extend the advantage 2-0. The Isotopes erupted for seven runs in the bottom of the second, sending 12 batters to the plate through the inning. Matt Angle sparked the onslaught with a ground rule double and scored one batter later on a single from Tony Gwynn Jr., making it 3-0. Ozzie Martinez followed with a base hit of his own, and after an errant pickoff attempt allowed both runners to advance a bag, Elian Herrera flared a two-run single to right, widening the lead 5-0. After a walk and a base hit loaded the bases, Scott Van Slyke gave Albuquerque a 7-0 edge with a two-run double. Following a Storm Chasers pitching change, Angle smoked a grounder into right, plating two more to conclude the big inning with the 'Topes on top 9-0. After Omaha finally found the scoreboard with a run in the fourth, the visitors added another tally in the sixth on a solo shot from Clint Robinson, cutting the deficit 9-2, but the 'Topes quickly erased the run with two of their own in the seventh. Sands and Van Slyke got the offense going with back-to-back singles, and both were picked up by a base hit from Gwynn Jr. to pull ahead 11-2 en route to a commanding 11-3 win.

ONE LAST CHANCE AT 11: After 11 straight appearances over more than two months, right-hander Will Savage has one last chance to win that elusive 11th game of the season, with his 10th triumph coming back on June 25. It helps that Savage is currently pitching some of his best baseball, posting a 1.50 ERA (3 ER / 18.0 IP) over his last three starts. His last outing typifies the kind of luck the right-hander has had of late, as Savage tossed 6.0 scoreless innings against Oklahoma City, scattering seven hits and walking one but nevertheless wound up with a no-decision after the RedHawks scored four in the seventh and two more in the eighth to take a 6-1 victory. It also helps that Savage has enjoyed success against the Storm Chasers this season, going 2-0 with a 4.82 ERA (5 ER / 9.1 IP) in four appearances, one of them a start.

THE LAND OF EN-BATS-MENT: Isotopes hitters wasted little time getting back in the groove after a very tough road trip. The 'Topes scored as many runs in the second inning of last night's 11-3 whipping of Omaha (seven) as they did in four total games at Oklahoma City. You'd expect Albuquerque's offense to perform better at hitter-friendly Isotopes Park, but the 'Topes as a team are batting almost 80 points better at home vs. on the road (.336 vs. .257). The Isotopes score an average of 7.1 runs a game in the Duke City and 4.6 runs a game on the road.

HOMER DROUGHT: For a team loaded with firepower, the Isotopes have surprisingly gone five straight games without hitting a home run, their longest homer drought of the 2012 season. Even with the lull, Albuquerque is still tied with Oklahoma City for the fourth most long balls hit on the year with 145.

MAGIC NUMBER DWINDLES: Thanks to last night's win, the Isotopes' Magic Number for winning the PCL's American Southern Division is now just two, meaning a win tonight coupled with an Oklahoma City loss vs. Round Rock and the 'Topes are headed to the postseason. Albuquerque currently holds a 1.5 game lead in the division with just three contests to play.

THE LAST WALTZ: Fan Appreciation Weekend rolls on with a huge Saturday filled with giveaways. The first 3,000 fans will get 'Topes Tote Bag and an Isotopes Grab Bag filled with some of the most popular giveaways from throughout the season. It'll all be capped with the second of three straight fireworks shows! Tomorrow, the team will be giving away more grab bags and have yet another fireworks extravaganza!

TODAY'S START: Will Savage takes the mound coming off a tough-luck no-decision when he pitched spectacularly on August 27 at Oklahoma City, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings, yielding seven hits and a walk while striking out one in a game ultimately won by the RedHawks 6-1. Placed on Disabled List on August 10 (retroactive to August 8) with a lower back strain. Reinstated on August 17. Made one relief outing on July 17 vs Memphis to get some work in and coaxed an inning-ending groundout on his first pitch. Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories equaling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP). Entered the game on April 18 vs. Iowa in the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected and pitched a then-season-high 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out two to earn his third victory of the season.

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 4.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22 at Lansing.

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer earned runs in 15 of them.

Saw action in just six games for Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization in 2008 before going on the Disabled List with a right elbow injury... diagnosed with a slight tear in the ulnar collateral ligament but did not require surgery.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: William P. Savage... attended El Camino Real High School in the San Fernando Valley... played college ball at the University of Oklahoma... attended College of the Canyons JC (Valencia, CA) where he played baseball and football... in 2003, quarterbacked the COC football team to a championship and the program's first undefeated season, going 10-0.
