‘TOPES EVEN SERIES WITH 5-3 WIN OVER CHASERS: With the team desperate for a solid pitching performance, the dynamic duo of Stephen Fife and Scott Rice delivered, guiding the Albuquerque Isotopes to a thrilling 5-3 win over the Omaha Storm Chasers Thursday night at Werner Park. For the second straight game, Omaha grabbed an early lead, plating a pair in the second on a two-run homer by Max Ramirez and another in the fourth on an RBI double by Rey Navarro to grab a 3-0 lead, but that’s all the starter Fife would allow, as the right-hander authored 7.0 sterling frames, allowing just the three tallies on seven hits while walking one and striking out five. With Fife keeping the Storm Chasers in relative check, the ‘Topes launched their comeback in the sixth inning. With a runner on first and second, Trent Oeltjen lined a two-out triple off the wall in the right field corner, plating two and bringing Albuquerque within 3-2. One inning later, the ‘Topes grabbed their first lead of the series, thanks to some shaky Omaha defense. With the bases loaded and one out, Josh Fields hit a ground ball in the gap between second and first in the direction of Navarro. The second baseman made a yeoman’s effort to get to the ball, but bobbed it once it was corralled, allowing two runs to score, giving the visitors a 4-3 edge. Albuquerque would add an invaluable insurance tally in the eighth when Bard ignited the uprising by lacing a two-out double off the wall in left. Tony Gwynn Jr. hit a slow roller to Navarro, which the second baseman picked up and threw wildly past first, allowing Bard to score and put the ‘Topes ahead 5-3. It was then up to reliever Rice to make the lead stand and the lefty shut down the Chasers in the eighth and the ninth to secure his first 2.0 inning save since 2006 and send Albuquerque gleefully to a 5-3 triumph.

LEANING ON LOOP: Derrick Loop makes the start coming of a brief outing against Omaha on Sept. 3 in which he was limited to just 2.0 innings of work, allowing an unearned run on no hits while walking and striking out one. The lefty has worked extremely well at home this year, going 6-2 with a 3.65 ERA in 16 appearances and six starts. Loop has won six of his last seven decisions at Isotopes Park, a span dating back to May 17 in which he has allowed just 17 earned runs through 47.0 frames of work, good for a remarkable 3.26 ERA. Against the Storm Chasers, the ‘Topes left-hander owns a 1-0 mark with a 5.40 ERA through three appearances, highlighted by two scoreless outings on April 8 and Sept. 3.

POSTSEASON AT THE LAB: The Isotopes return to Albuquerque for the first postseason games played in the Duke City since September 9-10, 2009, and are making their return home hoping to snap a streak. In four previous PCL playoff games played at Isotopes Park, the ‘Topes are 0-4, with their only postseason win previous to last night’s triumph coming on September 4, 2003 when Albuquerque topped Nashville 7-5 at Greer Stadium. After that win, the Isotopes dropped two in a row at home to the Sounds before starting the 2009 American Conference Championship series with two straight defeats at The Lab to Memphis. The good news is Albuquerque finished the regular season with the best home record in the PCL and come into tonight’s contest having won four of six games against Omaha at Isotopes Park.

RELIABLE RICE: Albuquerque reliever Scott Rice authored 2.0 scoreless innings last night, picking up the save while helping preserve a 5-3 win over Omaha. The southpaw has dialed in on the mound through his previous six appearances, and with last night’s performance, has not allowed a run through his last 6.1 innings, a stretch that dates back to Aug. 23. Rice’s save last night was his 10th of the season and his first since July 23 vs. Iowa, and with regular closer Josh Wall on recall to the Dodgers, Rice now paces the ‘Topes’ pitching staff in saves.

FIELDS OF DREAMS: With his 2-for-5 performance yesterday against Omaha, Isotopes infielder Josh Fields has now collected at least one hit in 14 of 17 contests against the Storm Chasers. Through this year’s campaign, Fields is batting a scorching .362 (25x69) when facing the ‘Chasers, including 12 runs scored, five doubles, two triples, two home runs and 14 RBI.

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop makes the start coming of a brief outing against Omaha on Sept. 3 in which he was limited to just 2.0 innings of work, allowing an unearned run on no hits while walking and striking out one. Took the loss at Oklahoma City on Aug. 29, his first defeat in over his previous four starts, surrendering three runs on six hits while walking one and fanning two in 5.0 frames. Made shortest start since his first of the season on August 23 at Memphis in which he lasted 3.0 innings, allowing six runs on five hits while walking three and striking out three in an eventual 9-0 'Topes loss. Earned his 11th win of the season, a stellar outing vs. New Orleans on August 19 when he pitched 6.2 shutout innings, allowing just three hits and three walks while striking out four in a 6-0 Isotopes win. Became the third Isotopes pitcher to earn double-digit wins this season after steering the 'Topes to a 7-2 victory over Tucson in the second game of a twin-bill on August 9, allowing just two runs on three hits through 6.0 frames, while fanning five and walking two. Had his best start of the season even though it resulted in a no-decision on July 24 at Round Rock when he pitched a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits while walking one and striking out a season-high five. Loop didn't figure in the decision, however, as the Express won 5-4 in 11 innings. Made his first start of the season on June 28 at Memphis, his first since August 27, 2011, going 3.0 innings, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his second-career Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-season-high 4.0 innings in a win vs. Oklahoma City on May 28, the third in a string of three straight victorious decisions, also a season-high.

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater... left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 consecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a 5.29 (20 ER / 34.0 IP) in 19 games (two starts)... held left-handed hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Started the 2010 season with Camden in the Independent Atlantic League, going 0-1 with a 1.72 (6 ER / 31.1 IP) in 33 games... walked just 17 batters while striking out 40... signed with the Phillies on July 14 and began season with Single-A Clearwater... was on DL, from August 15-22... did not allow an earned run in 14 of his 15 relief appearances with Clearwater before being promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5 for his Triple-A debut... averaged 10.29 SO / 9.0 IP between both levels... held opponents to a combined .165 avg (15x91)... played for Aguilas in Dominican Winter League (16 G, 1-1, 2.79 ERA).

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fourth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June 25... set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Derrick A. Loop... attended Norco High School in Norco, California before playing college baseball at California State University - Los Angeles.
