ISOTOPES RALLY FALLS SHORT IN 7-4 GAME THREE LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes mounted a late rally, plating three runs in the eighth to pull within two, but it wasn't enough as the 'Topes ultimately fell 7-4 to the Omaha Storm Chasers Friday night at Isotopes Park. After Omaha plated three in the third, the Chasers padded their lead in seventh when Derrick Robinson poked a single to right and was immediately picked up by a two-run homer from Mitch Maier. The 'Topes then finally found the scoreboard in the bottom of the frame as Matt Angle roped a one-out double to left and scored on an RBI two-bagger from Tyler Ogle to cut the deficit 5-1. The Storm Chasers added a run in the eighth on an RBI single from Irving Falu, pulling ahead 6-1 just as Albuquerque began to claw its way back into the contest. Dee Gordon began the rally when he was plunked by a pitch, advanced to second on a walk to Josh Fields and scored on a base hit from Jerry Sands to bring the Isotopes within 6-2. Two batters later, Trent Oeltjen cut the Chasers advantage to 6-3 with a run-scoring single to left-center. Following an Omaha pitching change, Angle ripped a grounder back to Storm Chasers reliever Donnie Joseph, who in an attempt to turn a double play, sent an errant throw sailing into centerfield that allowed Sands to score from second and make the score 6-4. Albuquerque's comeback attempt proved in vain as the Chasers plated one more run in the ninth courtesy an RBI single from Anthony Seratelli, before calling upon reliever Roman Colon to slam the door. Holding a three-run lead, Omaha's righty retired three of four 'Topes batters to close out the victory and send the Storm Chasers to a 7-4 triumph

MR. PRESSURE: For the second straight start, lefty Cole St. Clair takes the mound facing a must-win situation. On September 2, with the 'Topes desperately trying to hold off the Oklahoma City RedHawks, St. Clair delivered a gem, holding these Storm Chasers

to just two hits through 4.0 innings while walking four and striking out one in a 6-5 win that ultimately helped Albuquerque clinch its division. Tonight, while the southpaw is tasked with literally keeping the Isotopes' 2012 season alive, the pressure can be alleviated by the fact he's pitched well down the stretch. In his last four appearances (three relief outings and one start), St. Clair has posted a 3.24 ERA (4 ER / 11.1 IP). He's also allowed just one home run in his last 11 outings (34.0 IP).

BACKS AGAINST THE WALL: Trailing two games to one in the series, the Isotopes must win their next two games in order to keep their season alive. What bodes will for the 'Topes is they just closed out the regular season by taking two in a row from these very Chasers not even a week ago and have not lost back-to-back home games in over a month. The last time Albuquerque fell in consecutive games at Isotopes Park was on August 5 and 6, when the Isotopes lost two contests to the Tucson Sidewinders. In fact, Albuquerque has lost back-to-back games at home just four times all season.

LEFT OF CENTER: With a pair of left-handers scheduled to start the next two games for Omaha, the Isotopes will look to maintain their success against southpaws. This season, the 'Topes posted a 32-18 record against left-handed starters and their only win so far this post-season came against port-sider Ryan Verdugo. Albuquerque's team batting average against Doug Davis and Justin Marks (tomorrow's scheduled starter) is a combined .419 (18x43) with the 'Topes scoring 17 total runs on the two pitchers in 6.2 innings.

ELIAN AND ON AND ON: Thanks to two more hits, including a double, last night, Elian Herrera continues to enjoy an excellent postesason. The infielder is batting .364 (4x11) with a double and three RBI in three games. Dating back to the regular season, Herrera is enjoying an eight game hitting streak in which he's batted .452 (14x31) with five multi-hit performances over that span.

TODAY'S START: Cole St. Clair makes his fourth start, but his second in a must-win situation after a solid performance on September 2 vs. Omaha. With the 'Topes looking to hold off second-place Oklahoma City, St. Clair delivered 4.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits while walking four and striking out one in a 6-5 Albuquerque win. Pitched a season-high 5.2 innings in his last start on August 1 vs. Las Vegas. Had a fine showing in his first start on July 27 at Round Rock when he suffered a hard-luck defeat after allowing just two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings while walking one and striking out two in a 5-1 'Topes loss. The outing marked the first start of his professional career and his first since he was a senior at Rice University in 2008. Had appeared in 38 games as a reliever this year, going 3-1 with a 4.64 ERA (34 ER / 66.0 IP). Had a three game winning streak from May 7 to to June 24 with all three decisions coming at home. Won his first career Triple-A game on May 7 vs. Nashville when he pitched 4.0 innings of relief, allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out two in an 8-3 Isotopes win. Went six straight appearances from April 16 to May 5 without giving up a run, a span of 7.1 innings. Did

2011: Went 1-5 with a 3.04 ERA (17 ER / 50.1 IP) and two saves with Double-A Chattanooga... was second on the Lookouts with 42 appearances... fanned 46 batters while walking 13... limited opposing hitters to a .242 (43x178) batting average, including a .212 (21x99) mark against right-handers... selected as a Southern League All-Star after posting 0.83 ERA (2 ER / 21.2 IP) in 19 first-half appearances... did not allow a run in seven June appearances (7.0 IP)... allowed just four runs in an 18-game (22.0 IP) span from May through July (1.63 ERA).

Appeared in 30 games for Single-A Great Lakes in 2009, going 4-1 with a 2.48 ERA (10 ER / 36.1 IP) and 15 saves... did not allow a run over his final 13 appearances (14.0 IP) for the Loons... overall, limited opposing hitters to a .226 average (30x133) with 45 strikeouts in 36.1 innings... successfully converted each of his nine save opportunities... won the August/September Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes, going 1-0 with seven saves, not allowing a run in 10.0 innings and limiting opponents to a .194 average (7x36) with 11 strikeouts in nine August games.

Selected by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2008 draft and began his professional career at Rookie-Level Ogden, posting no record and an 3.18 ERA (6 ER / 17.0 IP) and five saves in 12 games... fanned 22 while walking just five.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Allen Cole St. Clair... went 10-3 with five saves and a 3.03 ERA in 24 games (three starts) as a senior with Rice in 2008... had been selected by Cleveland in the seventh round of the 2007 draft, but chose to return to Rice for his senior season... graduated from Rice with a Bachelor's degree in Economics... was named the winner of the 2008 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, an honor that identifies personal qualities that define a complete student-athlete... was named a *Baseball America* First-Team College All-American after his sophomore season in 2006... pitched for Team USA in 2006, winning the Gold Medal at the FISU World Championships in Havana, Cuba... pitched in three College World Series from 2006-08... was a teammate of Phillip Hughes at Foothill High School in Santa Ana... his father Jay played basketball at the University of Southern California.
