‘TOPES MOUNT EPIC COMEBACK TO EVEN SERIES: The Albuquerque Isotopes plated a season-high nine runs in the seventh inning, marking their largest deficit overcome in 2012, to claim a 12-10 epic victory over the Omaha Storm Chasers Saturday night at Isotopes Park. Trailing 10-3 in the bottom of the seventh, with the season all but over, the Isotopes began their biggest comeback of the year when Josh Fields knocked an RBI single to left, cutting the lead 10-4. Jerry Sands followed with a double that bounced into right field, scoring two and narrowing the deficit 10-6. The Isotopes weren't nearly finished, however, as Scott Van Slyke followed with a two-bagger of his own, plating Sands to draw within 10-7. Matt Angle then gave the ‘Topes another run on an RBI line drive that was scorched right at Jason Bourgeois, and as the right fielder attempted to cut down Van Slyke at the plate, the Isotopes runner was able to dance around the tag and touch home, making the score 10-8. Josh Bard then kept the bats alive with a single to left, and with two runners on, Tony Gwynn Jr. blasted a three-run homer that sailed into the berm, completing the comeback and giving Albuquerque an 11-10 lead. Elian Herrera gave the ‘Topes a valuable insurance run when he smoked a triple off the right-field wall and came home two batters later on a sac-fly from Fields to pad the advantage 12-10. Albuquerque reliever Lorenzo Barcelo was then tasked with protecting the lead through the eighth and ninth, and did so with aplomb, allowing a hit to lead off the eighth before retiring the next six Chasers in a row to seal the 12-10 win.

SAVAGE STEPS UP: Will Savage makes the start today at the most opportune time in which to capture his ever-elusive 11th win, which has evaded the right-hander since he reached double-digit victories on June 25. Aside from his most recent regular-season outing against Omaha, Savage has turned in three consecutive solid starts in which the hurler has posted an incredible 1.50 ERA by allowing just three runs through 18.0 innings of work, including 6.0 scoreless frames at Oklahoma City on August 27. Also, despite the tough appearance against the Storm Chasers on September 1, the ‘Topes righty has routinely fared well when facing Omaha, limiting their powerful lineup to two runs or fewer in four of his other five outings.

ONE FOR ALL THE MARBLES: Last night's unbelievable comeback has set the stage for a one-game showdown to decide who will advance to the Pacific Coast League Championship series beginning next week. With Sacramento evening its series at Reno last night, this will be the first time since 2008 that the two teams battling for the PCL crown will have advanced in five games.

TRIPLE THREAT: Elian Herrera etched his name in the Isotopes record books by becoming the first person in franchise history to hit two triples in a single inning when belted a pair of three-baggers in the seventh. Herrera is also the first player in team history to record two triples in a single game three times, with each of those occasions ironically coming against the Storm Chasers (4/8 on the road; 9/1 at home).

BIG TIME TONY: Tony Gwynn launched a three-run homer last night to propel the ‘Topes to an 11-10 edge over the Storm Chasers. The longball was Gwynn's first home run in over a year, with his last big-fly coming on August 19, 2011 while he was with the Dodgers, a solo shot off Edgmer Escalona of the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field. Dating even further back, the three-run shot was Gwynn's first homer with runners on base since June 13, 2010, when, as a member of the San Diego Padres, he belted a two-run dinger off Felix Hernandez of the Seattle Mariners at PETCO Park.

COMEBACK KIDS!: The seven-run comeback was not only the greatest in Isotopes playoff history, it ranks as the third largest deficit erased in franchise annals. Albuquerque overcame an eight run hole in 2008 and set a record by erasing an 11 run lead in 2010.

WITNESS HISTORY!: If the ‘Topes prevail today, they will advance to the PCL Championship Series against the winner of the set between Reno and Sacramento. Like in the first round, the Isotopes would go on the road for the first two games before returning home on Friday, September 14 for game three. Games four and five would also be at The Lab on Saturday and Sunday, if necessary. Don't miss out on more incredible action at Isotopes Park. TODAY'S START: Will Savage makes the Game 5 start coming off his seventh loss of the season on September 1 when he worked 4.0 innings against Omaha, allowing six runs on nine hits while walking two and striking out two in a 14-10 'Topes loss. Took a tough-luck no-decision when he pitched spectacularly on August 27 at Oklahoma City, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings, yielding seven hits and a walk while striking out one in a game ultimately won by the RedHawks 6-1. Placed on Disabled List on August 10 (retroactive to August 8) with a lower back strain. Reinstated on August 17. Made one relief outing on July 17 vs Memphis to get some work in and coaxed an inning-ending groundout on his first pitch. Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories equalling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP). Entered the game on April 18 vs. Iowa in the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected and pitched a then-season-high 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out two to earn his third victory of the season.

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 9.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22 at Lansing.

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer earned runs in 15 of them.

Saw action in just six games for Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization in 2008 before going on the Disabled List with a right elbow injury... diagnosed with a slight tear in the ulnar collateral ligament but did not require surgery.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: William P. Savage... attended El Camino Real High School in the San Fernando Valley... played college ball at the University of Oklahoma... attended College of the Canyons JC (Valencia, CA) where he played baseball and football... in 2003, quarterbacked the COC football team to a championship and the program's first undefeated season, going 10-0.
